Chairman Cobble made a motion to accept the draft of Section 6.08
Chairman *Pro tem* Wood seconded the motion.
The GCCC voted unanimously to accept Section 6.08

The GCCC eliminated Section 8.01 e.

The GCCC listened to citizens speak about the issue of referendums.
