The Greene County Legislative Body met in regular session on Monday, August 18, 2014 at the Greene County Courthouse.

Mayor Broyles called the meeting to order to transact business that is to lawfully come before this Honorable Body. Commissioner Seay led the Pledge to the Flag, followed by Prayer led by Commissioner Rollins. The Commissioners signed in on their key pads and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Bird; Bowers, Carter, Crum, Dabbs, Greenway, Hensley, Holt, Hopson, Kiker, King, Malone, McAmis, Moss, Quillen, Rollins, Sams, Sauceman, Seay, Waddle and White were present. There were 21 Commissioners present and 0 absent.

PUBLIC HEARING

- Mayor Broyles thanked everyone for their service, saying he enjoyed his years as the County Mayor.
- Mayor Broyles read proclamation for John Francis Haws Jr, who is turning 100 years old on September 10, 2014.
- Judy Sexton spoke about how she didn't want a property tax raise. She also spoke about the school director and assistant's pay.
- Glen Coffey then spoke about the danger for young people to be at intersections at 107 Cutoff and Greystone Road, collecting money when there are big dump trucks coming and going to the sand company.
- Mayor Broyles called on Budget Director, Mary Shelton. She reported about the debt obligation on the Insurance Capital Outlay Note, Series 2014 for school busses. She noted the report has to be filed with the minutes.
- Commissioner Anthony Sauceman then called on Steven Stout. He spoke about how much Greene County EMS had charged him for a trip from Urgent Care to Takoma Hospital. EMS Director, Robert Sayne, told him to come by his office and they would explain his bill.



**A RESOLUTION OF GREENE COUNTY, TENNESSEE IN SUPPORT
OF AMENDMENT 1 ON THE NOVEMBER 4TH, 2014 GENERAL
ELECTION BALLOT AND ENCOURAGING SUPPORT OF THE SAME.**

WHEREAS: The Greene County Legislative Body supports the sovereignty of the People through their elected representatives to direct public policy in matters of public interest at all levels of government; and

WHEREAS: In 2000 the Supreme Court of Tennessee in its decision in Planned Parenthood v. Sundquist removed from the people of Tennessee the power to enforce common-sense regulations and laws concerning the practice of abortion in this State; and

WHEREAS: Other states, including states surrounding Tennessee, have passed laws concerning abortions and abortion facilities such as laws requiring informed consent, licensing of facilities, health inspections of facilities, and short waiting periods. These laws have not been overturned by the Federal courts; and

WHEREAS: Tennessee has been rendered unable to enforce such laws and regulations because of the case cited above and subsequent cases, Tennessee has become an abortion destination ranking third in the nation in the percentage of abortions performed for women who have traveled here from other states for that purpose; and

WHEREAS: Tennessee Constitutional Law is currently such that overturning Roe v. Wade at the Federal level would not change anything about the practice of abortion in Tennessee and is such that pro-abortion rights organizations refer to Tennessee's Constitutional Law as more favorable to their point of view than Federal Constitutional Law; and

WHEREAS: There will appear on to the November 4, 2014 General Election Ballot an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Tennessee which, if approved by the voters of Tennessee, will nullify the effect of the ruling in Planned Parenthood v. Sundquist and return the power to the people of this state, acting through their elected representatives, to regulate the abortion industry in this state within the limits set forth by Federal Constitutional Law. 

WHEREAS, this pilot program would be established for six (6) months and would only be available to non-violent criminal offenders who would be permitted to participate in the program at the Judge's discretion and who would be totally responsible for any and all costs of the program during the initial pilot period; and


WHEREAS, it would appear that the implementation of the program would provide sufficient safe guards for the community by monitoring not only the location of the offender but would also monitor and identify possible drug use or abuse by individuals wearing the ankle bracelets, would reduce the cost of incarceration of convicted criminal offenders, would save tax dollars in reducing the costs to house non-violent offenders who qualify for the program, avoid paying medical expenses for individuals who are released under the program, and would provide an opportunity for non-violent criminal offenders to remain with their family, remain employed and further assist those non-violent criminal offenders in rehabilitation.

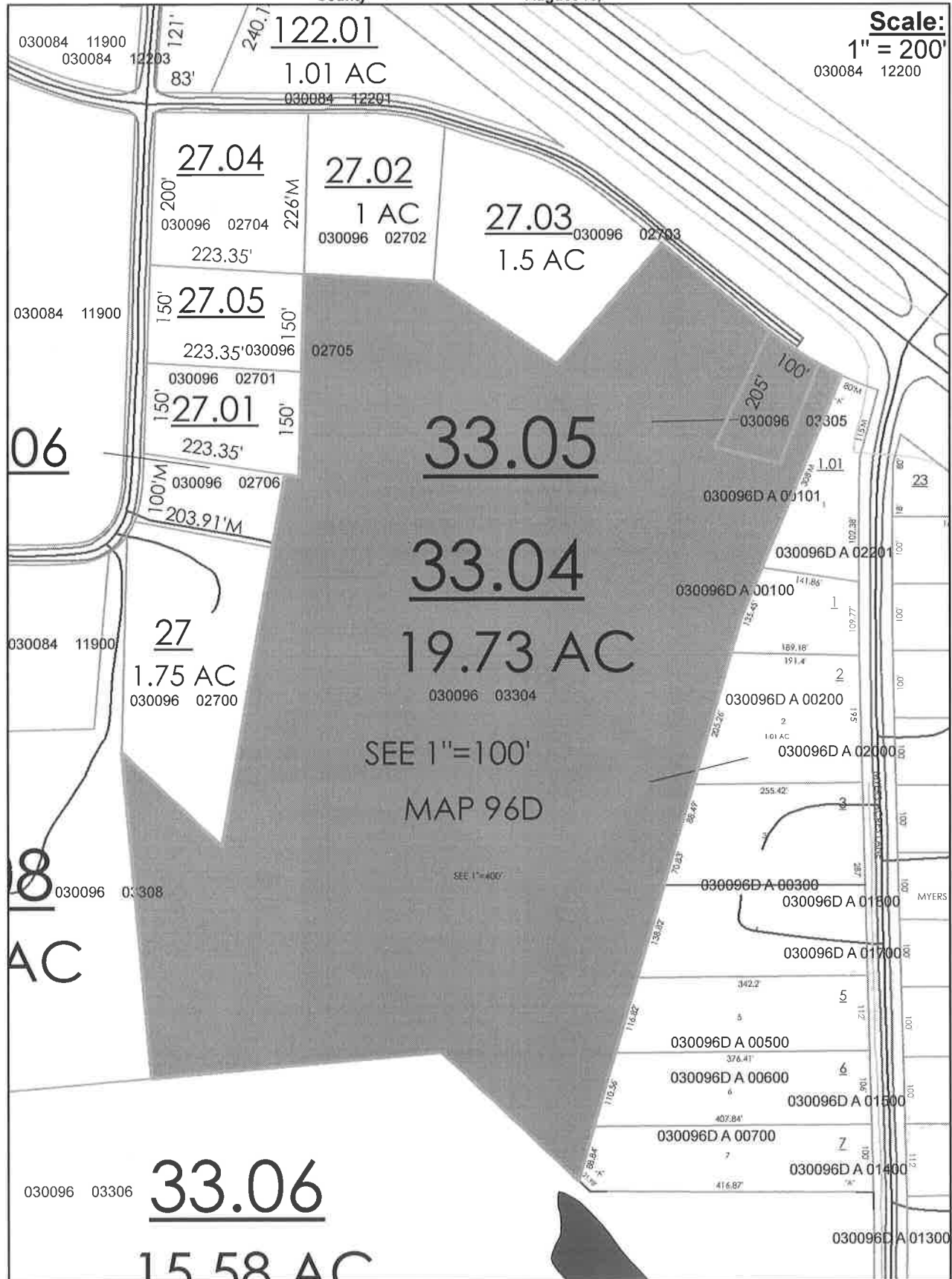

RESOLUTION TO ASK THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO REPEAL THE PROVISIONS OF T.C.A. § 8-24-102(d),(e), AND (g), T.C.A. 8-23-103, T.C.A. 16-15-5003, AND T.C.A. 2-12-208 (a) AS IT RELATES TO THE MINIMUM COMPENSATION AND MANDATORY SALARY ADJUSTMENTS FOR COUNTY OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, the General Assembly by enacting T.C.A. § 8-24-102(d),(e) and (g), T.C.A. §8-23-103, T.C.A. §16-15-5003, and T.A.C. §2-12-208(a) imposed minimum salaries and mandated increases in annual salaries of various county officials including assessors of property, county clerks, clerks and masters of chancery courts, clerks of probate courts, clerks of circuit courts, clerks of general sessions courts, clerks of criminal courts, juvenile court clerks, county trustees, registers of deeds, administrators of elections, sheriffs, chief administrative officers of the county highway department, county mayors, and general sessions judges.; and

WHEREAS, in view of the dismal economic conditions overall in the State of Tennessee and in particular in Greene County, the Greene County Legislative Body strongly object to the "minimum compensation" as well as the mandatory salary adjustments for county officials and county officers listed in paragraph one of this resolution and mandated by state law that compel county governments to pay its county officials compensation at the mandated minimum salary levels and require annual adjustments without any input from the County Government or consideration of the economic conditions within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Legislative Body's opposition to the minimum salaries and mandatory adjustments is based not only on the practical financial concerns for this County as well as other county governments throughout the State, but also with the fundamental disagreement that the State Legislature is better able to determine a just compensation for its county officials than the county legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Legislative Body further expresses its disagreement and actual bewilderment in the logic of legislation that joins together the annual salary adjustments of the county officials with the State's average annualized general increase for state employees' compensation and/or formula utilized by the State of Tennessee.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Greene County Legislative Body meeting in regular session on the 18th day of August, 2014, a quorum being present, a majority voting in the affirmative that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Speaker of the House, our elected State Senator and State Representatives who represent Greene County in the General Assembly, and to the State of Tennessee County Commissioner Association requesting that they each sponsor and/or support legislation that would:

(1) Repeal T.C.A. § 8-24-102 (d),(e), (g), T.C.A. §8-23-103, T.C.A. §16-15-5003, and T.C.A. §2-12-208 (a) mandating minimum salaries and required annual adjustments for county officials including assessors of property, county clerks, clerks and masters of chancery courts, clerks of probate courts, clerks of circuit courts, clerks of general sessions courts, clerks of criminal courts, juvenile court clerks, county trustees and registers of deeds, administrator of elections, chief administrative officers of the county highway department, sheriff, county mayor, and general session judge.

(2) Allow each county legislative body to determine the salaries of its county officials as well as any annual adjustments for each county official based on all the relative factors that should be utilized to determine the approximate salary for each county official.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk forward a copy of this Resolution to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Speaker of the House, our elected State Senator and State Representatives who represent Greene County in the General Assembly, and to the State of Tennessee County Commissioner Association requesting their sponsorship and support of the issues contained in this Resolution before the General Assembly.

H. A RESOLUTION OF THE GREENE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY
FIXING THE TAX LEVY IN GREENE COUNTY, TENNESSEE FOR THE YEAR
BEGINNING JULY 1, 2014

A motion was made by Commissioner Seay and seconded by Commissioner Crum to approve a resolution of the Greene County Legislative body fixing the tax levy in Greene County, Tennessee for the year beginning July 1, 2014.

Discussion before vote was on the 11.5 cent tax rate with eight positions cut and employee hours cut four hours each week. County Attorney Roger Woolsey informed the Commissioners that plans to cut positions could expose County to lawsuits from Department heads.

Mayor Broyles then called for the Commissioners to vote on their keypads. The following vote was taken: Commissioners Crum, Moss, and Seay voted yes. Commissioners Bird, Bowers, Carter, Dabbs, Greenway, Holt, Kiker, King, Malone, McAmis, Moss, Quillen, Rollins, Sams, Seay, Waddle, and White voted no. Commissioner Sauceman abstained. The vote was 3 – aye; 17 – nay; 1 – abstain; 0 – absent. The Commissioners voted against the motion to approve the resolution.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bowers and seconded by Commissioner Crum to raise the tax 15 cents with no cuts. Mayor Broyles then called for the Commissioners to vote on their keypads. The following vote was taken: Commissioners McAmis, Malone, White, Carter, Hopson, Hensley, Bird, Moss, Dabbs, and Sams, voted yes. Commissioners Bowers, Quillen, King, Rollins, Seay, Greenway, Holt, Waddle, Crum, and Kiker, voted no. Commissioner Sauceman abstained. Mayor Broyles broke the

tie with a vote of no. The vote was 10 – aye; 11 – nay; 1 – abstain; 0 – absent. The Commissioners voted against this motion.

A motion was then made by Commissioner Bowers and seconded by Commissioner Seay to reconsider to vote again on 11.5 cent tax increase. Mayor Broyles then called for the Commissioners to vote on their keypads. The following vote was taken: Commissioners Quillen, Bowers, King, Rollins, Seay, Holt, Waddle, Moss, Crum, and Kiker voted yes. Commissioners McAmis, Malone, White, Carter, Hopson, Hensley, Bird, Greenway, Dabbs, and Sams voted no. Commissioner Sauceman abstained. Mayor Broyles broke the tie with a vote of yes. The vote was 11 – aye; 10 – nay; 1 – abstain; 0 – absent. The motion to reconsider passed.

Commissioner Hopson made a motion to adjourn due to the resolution had already been voted down. Commissioner Dabbs seconded the motion. Mayor Broyles then called on the Commissioners to vote on their keypads. The following vote was taken: Commissioners McAmis, Malone, White, Carter, Hopson, Hensley, Bird, Dabbs, and Sams voted yes. Commissioners Quillen, Bowers, King, Rollins, Sauceman, Seay, Greenway, Holt, Waddle, Moss, Crum, and Kiker voted no. The vote was 9 – aye; 12 – nay; 0 – absent. The motion to adjourn failed.

Commissioner Bowers then made the motion to vote again on a 15 cent tax increase with no cuts. Commissioner Seay seconded the motion. Mayor Broyles then called on the Commissioners to vote on their keypads. The following vote was taken: Commissioners Quillen, Bowers, King, Rollins, Seay, Moss, Crum, and Kiker, voted yes. Commissioner McAmis, Malone, White, Carter, Hopson, Hensley, Bird, Greenway, Holt,

Waddle, Dabbs, and Sams voted no. Commissioner Sauceman abstained. The vote was 8 – aye; 12 – nay; 1 – abstain; 0 – absent. The motion failed.

Commissioner Waddle made the motion for a 3 cent tax rate with cuts from the Sheriff's Department budget. Commissioner Malone seconded the motion. Mayor Broyles then called on the Commissioners to vote on their keypads. The following vote was taken: Commissioners Malone, Waddle, and Moss voted yes. Commissioners McAmis, White, Carter, Hopson, Hensley, Bird, Quillen, Bowers, King, Rollins, Seay, Greenway, Holt, Dabbs, Crum, Kiker, and Sams voted no. Commissioner Sauceman abstained. The vote was 3 – aye; 17 – nay; 1 – abstain; 0 – absent. The motion failed.

Commissioner Hopson then made the motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Moss seconded the motion. Mayor Broyles then called on the Commissioners to vote on their keypads. The following vote was taken: Commissioners McAmis, Malone, White, Carter, Hopson, Hensley, Bird, King, Rollins, Greenway, Holt, Moss, Dabbs, Kiker, and Sams voted yes. Commissioners Quillen, Bowers, Sauceman, Seay, Waddle, and Crum voted no. The vote was 15 – aye; 6 – nay; 0 – absent. The motion to adjourn passed.

The meeting adjourned.
