RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF GREENEVILLE AND THE TENNESSEE WILDLIFE RESOURCES AGENCY TO CONSTRUCT AND DEVELOP A FIRING RANGE, TESTING FACILITY AND EDUCATIONAL CENTER ON PROPERTY JOINTLY OWNED BY THE TOWN OF GREENEVILLE AND GREENE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Greene County and the Town of Greeneville jointly own and operate a firing range, testing facility and educational facility on Hal Henard Road, which facilities have been in place more than thirty years; and

WHEREAS, grant funding is now available through the Tennessee Wildlife Resources
Agency that could be utilized to greatly improve and further develop the firing range, to make
additional capital expenditures to develop skeet and trap ranges and construct an educational
facility for hunter education classes that would benefit not only local law enforcement agencies
but in addition thereto could by agreement be utilized by Walter State Community College in
their law enforcement certification training, high school competition shooting teams and the
citizens of Greene County; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding from the TWRA requires a local 25% match which match may be in the form of real property where the facility is located and/or in-kind labor and services by the County and Town; and

WHEREAS, Greene County and the Town of Greeneville presently own approximately 48 acres immediately behind and adjacent to the ball field complex on Hal Henard Road which property has not in the past been utilized by the County and Town and which property has little economic, educational, or industrial prospects other than for the uses in compliance with the uses contemplated by this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the fair market value of 48 acre tract as shown on the attached plat could be utilized as part of the local match provided that the property is forever restricted for any uses other than what is contained and described above including using said property as a firing

range, testing facility, and educational facility for hunter education training and competition; and

WHEREAS, it would appear that it would be in the best interest of the citizens of Greene County for the above specified tract be dedicated and set aside with a permanent easement for use as an educational facility, training facility and firing range for training and educational purposes related to the use of firearms and to enhance the training of both certified officers working for the various law enforcement departments in Greene County and to assist in training future post-certified officers enrolled in law enforcement training through Walter State Community College.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Greene County Legislative Body, meeting in regular session on the 16th day of December, 2013, a quorum being present and a majority voting in the affirmative, that the County Mayor for Greene County, Tennessee is authorized enter into negotiations and contract with TWRA and the Town of Greeneville to develop, improve and expand the present firing range located on Hal Henard Road, which would include the approximate 48 acres as shown on the plat attached to this Resolution for the development of an educational facility, testing facility and firing range as well as a competitive shooting venue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Mayor is authorized to execute such documents as is required to establish a permanent restrictive covenants requiring that the 48 acre tract including the present shooting range be forever used for the purposes as spelled out in this Resolution.

RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE GENERATED REVENUE FROM THE HOTEL/MOTEL TAX CURRENTLY DESIGNATED FOR PERFORMING ARTS EXCLUSIVELY TO THE NISWONGER PERFORMING ARTS CENTER

WHEREAS, previously Greene County had passed a motel/hotel tax currently the allocation of revenue generated by the motel/hotel tax is as follows: one and one-half percent (1½%) tax levied is retained by county government in the general fund and allocated for the direct support of industrial development, recruitment, and retention for all Greene County; one and one-half percent (1½%) of the tax shall be retained by county government and allocated for the direct support of development and support of tourism for Greene County; two percent (2%) of the tax shall allocated to the Greene County General Debt Service Fund; one percent (1%) of the tax shall be allocated to the county's capital improvement fund for construction, renovation, or maintenance of facilities, recreational pursuits or for the purchase of equipment; and the remaining one percent (1%) of the tax shall be allocated to support or promote the performing arts as allocated by the County Legislative Body; and

WHEREAS, the Niswonger Performing Arts Center provides a venue for a multitude of cultural activities and the performing arts for the adults and children of this community as well as providing a venue for many programs including but not limited to band concerts, citizenship ceremonies and other events; and

WHEREAS, because of the enhancements to the community above specified, the appropriated portion by Greene County of the hotel/motel tax be given exclusively to the Niswonger Performing Arts Center and no other performing arts venue which designation shall become effective July, 2014. With the exception of Capital Outlay Note obligations already in

existence for band-rooms and the ongoing Trustees commission the remaining allocation for performing arts shall go to the Niswonger Performing Arts Center.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Greene County Legislative Body, meeting in regular session on the 16th day of December, 2013, a quorum being present and a two-thirds majority voting in the affirmative, that the total allocated portion of the hotel/motel tax for performing arts be given exclusively to the Niswonger Performing Arts Center, which is allocated from fund 189 –Economic Development beginning July, 2014, with the exception of Capital Outlay Note obligations already in existence for band-rooms and the ongoing Trustees commission.

A RESOLUTION TO EMPLOY AN AUDITOR TO AUDIT THE MONTHLY TAX RETURNS OF ANY OPERATOR OF ANY MOTEL/HOTEL, ETC. IN GREENE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Greene County levied by Resolution a privilege tax upon the privilege of occupancy in any motel of each transit in Greene County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to T.C.A. § 67-4-1406 the Court Clerk is obligated to audit each operator in the County at least once per year and shall report from the audits made on a quarterly basis to the Legislative Body; and

WHEREAS, any operator who fails to remit to the County Court Clerk in a timely fashion taxes that are required is considered to be delinquent, which operator(s) shall be liable for interest on such delinquent taxes from the due date at a rate of 12% per annum and in addition thereto shall be obligated to pay a penalty; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration and deliberation it would appear that it would be manifestly in the best interest of the citizens of Greene County to employ an individual or firm trained and competent to provide such audits and to authorize the County Mayor to employee such individual after consultation with the County Court Clerk and the County Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Greene County Legislative Body meeting in regular session on the 16th day of December, 2013, a quorum being present and a majority is voting in the affirmative to authorize the County Mayor to employ with the consent of the County Court Clerk and County Attorney an auditor to audit each operator in Greene County of any motel/hotel, structure or space or any portion thereof that is occupied or designed for occupancy by transits for dwelling, lodging or sleeping purposes and includes any Hotel, Motel, Inn, Tourist Camp, Tourist
