A Proclamation for the 200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Beginning of the War of 1812

WHEREAS, the Bicentennial of the War of 1812 sometimes referred to as "The Second War for American Independence" officially began on June 18, 1812; and

WHEREAS, the sacrifices by those soldiers, citizens and their families that fought in the War of 1812, further defended the liberties previously won in the American Revolution; and

WHEREAS, those sacrifices included heroic efforts by Dolly Madison to save some of our National treasures from destruction during the burning of the White House by the British in 1814; and

WHEREAS, the conflict and bravery shown would inspire Francis Scott Key to write a poem describing the bombardment of Fort McHenry in Baltimore Harbor and the said writings would become our country's National Anthem, known as the Star Spangled Banner; and

WHEREAS, General Andrew Jackson helped win a stunning victory over the British in the Battle of New Orleans on 08 January 1815 that further solidified the United States independence from Great Britain; and

WHEREAS, one of the Veterans of the War of 1812, *Henry Earnest*, is buried in Greene County, TN and his descendants still live in his original homestead with other descendants living in the State of Texas that are members of the Thomas Bay Chapter #350 National Society United States Daughters of 1812, who wish to honor his service and whose primary purpose is to promote a more general awareness of the history of said war among the citizens of this nation:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Alan Broyles, Mayor of Greene County, Tennessee, do hereby recognize and proclaim **December 17, 2012** as

**"The War of 1812 Bicentennial Recognition Day"**

and urge all citizens to become more knowledgeable of the role the War of 1812 played in the history of our nation and of the citizens of the Great State of Texas.

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT TO  
ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE TOWN OF GREENEVILLE TO  
UPGRADE THE STORM DRAIN SYSTEM ON COLLEGE STREET IN THE TOWN  
OF GREENEVILLE**

WHEREAS, the Town of Greeneville has determined that a storm drainage system on College Street in the Town of Greeneville needs to be upgraded to carry the flow of water along that street and from Tusculum Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration based on the information provided, the Greene County Legislative Body has determined that the renovation of the storm drainage system on College Street will benefit the citizens of the Town of Greeneville as well as the citizens of Greene County as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Legislative Body, desires to cooperate with the Town of Greeneville to allow the Greene County Highway Department to upgrade the storm drainage system at the location described above; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to T.C.A. § 54-7-202(d) the costs associated with the upgrade of the storm drainage system on College Street by the Greene County Highway Department will be reimbursed to the Highway Department by the Town of Greeneville.

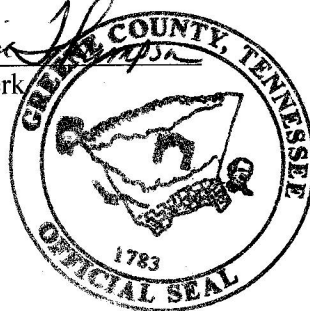
