THEREFORE, let the General Fund Budget be amended as follows:

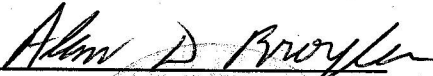

THEREFORE, let the Capital Projects budget be amended to the following:

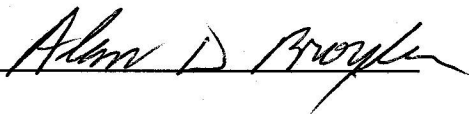

**RESOLUTION TO ASK THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO INDIVIDUAL
COUNTIES TO COVER THE COST OR EXPENSE IN PROVIDING ARMED UNIFORMED OFFICERS OR
SECURITY GUARDS AT INDIVIDUAL SCHOOLS IF SAME IS MANDATED BY THE STATE OF
TENNESSEE**

WHEREAS, the Greene County Board of Education in cooperation with the Greene County Sheriff's Department has a uniformed officer at each of the four high schools operated by the Board of Education in Greene County; and

WHEREAS, the eleven elementary schools and the alternative learning center does not have uniformed officers on premise at the present time; and

WHEREAS, in light of the tragedy that occurred at Sandy Hook Elementary School in Connecticut, there has been much discussion and speculation that the State of Tennessee might require each school system to provide armed uniformed officers or security guards at each school in operation in the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, without funding to implement such a program from the State of Tennessee such an unfunded mandate would in all probability cause serious financial issues for many of the school systems in the State of Tennessee and in particular for the Greene County Board of Education and for Greene County Government; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration by the Greene County Legislative Body it appears all factors being considered that if the State of Tennessee implements or adopts legislation that mandates that each school have on premises an armed uniformed officer or security guard that the State of Tennessee should provide sufficient funding for each Board of Education to pay the cost of such a mandate.

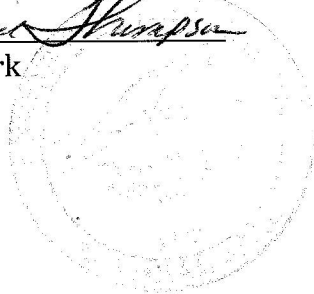
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Greene County Legislative Body meeting in regular session on the 22nd day of January, 2013, a quorum being present, a majority voting in the affirmative that a request be made to the General Assembly for the State of Tennessee that if the State adopts any legislation or program requiring an armed uniformed officers or security guard at individual schools that the State of Tennessee pay to the individual Boards of Education across

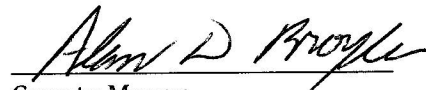
the State sufficient funds to cover any and all expenses, so long as such mandate existed, for the implementation of such a mandate.

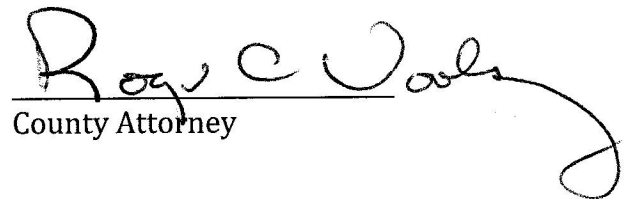
BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Clerk forward a copy of this Resolution to the elected State Senator and the State Representatives representing Greene County and that in addition thereto that a copy of said Resolution be forwarded to the Speaker of House and Senate Pro-Tem requesting their support, if in fact, the State of Tennessee mandates armed uniformed officers or security guards at each individual school within the State of Tennessee, that the State of Tennessee provide funding to each of the local Boards of Education to cover the expenses arising from such a mandate.
