GREENE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY
MONDAY, JUNE 17, 2013
10:00 AM

The Greene County Legislative Body met in regular session on Monday, June 17, 2013 at the Greene County Courthouse.

Mayor Broyles called the meeting to order to transact business that is to lawfully come before this Honorable Body. Commissioner Seay led the Pledge to the Flag, followed by Prayer led by Commissioner Rollins. The Commissioners signed in on their key pads and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Bird; Bowers, Carter, Crum, Dabbs, Greenway, Hensley, Holt, Hopson, Kiker, King, Malone, McAmis, Moss, Quillen, Rollins, Sams, Sauceman, Seay, Waddle and White were present. There were 21 Commissioners present and 0 absent.

PUBLIC HEARING

Michelle Keffer, manager of Tennessee Rehabilitation Center spoke on services offered by Tennessee Rehabilitation Center and funding from local government and federal match.

Kathy Franklin was called on by Commissioner Jan Kiker. Kathy is the owner of a small local business and has experience with Tennessee Rehabilitation Center.

Larry Parman, Rolling Hills Rd, spoke about Tahoe vehicles ordered, wheel tax, property tax, litigation tax, county personnel, and school department.


A MOTION TO APPROVE NOTARIES


**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR TO MAKE APPLICATION TO
THE STATE OF TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND
SUBSTANCE ABUSE SERVICES FOR A \$50,000 GRANT FROM
THE TENNESSEE CERTIFIED DRUG COURT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services, is offering Greene County a Grant totaling \$50,000 to provide funds to support a case manager position to work with the drug court participants and to provide funds to support the taxes/benefits related to the salary of the position. The grant will also provide for funding for supplies, telephone charges, travel/conferences and meetings, and for professional fees related to treatment services such as transitional housing, half way housing, out-patient services, etc. This grant will also provide funding for, transportation costs, emergency medicines and housing deposits for drug court participants; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of Greene County and Greene County citizens to have this funding and position to enable the court's capacity to increase and allow additional participants access to the services needed to remain out of jail and living productively in the community. There is no match required by Greene County and the program will terminate if and when funding is withdrawn by the State of Tennessee Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services ; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Greene County Legislative Body, meeting in regular session on the 17th day of June, 2013, a quorum being present and a majority voting in the affirmative, that the County Mayor for Greene County, Tennessee is authorized to make application through State of Tennessee Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services for the Certified Drug Court Program Grant.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Mayor is authorized to enter into any and all necessary agreements and assurances to implement the application and subsequent project.





THEREFORE, let the General Fund Budget be amended as follows:






