

GCCC Meeting Minutes

March 19, 2015

The GCCC held its March 19 meeting at the Greene County Courthouse Annex. Chairman Cobble opened in prayer.

Chairman Cobble made a motion to accept the minutes from February 14 and March 14 meetings.

Commissioner Davenport seconded the motion.

The GCCC voted 6-0 to accept these minutes with Commissioner Claiborne abstaining because of his absence at the March 14 meeting.

The GCCC discussed removing term limits of School Board members and the Circuit Court Clerk.

The GCCC agreed to exempt these offices from term limits and add the language dealing with term limits to Article 3.

The GCCC reviewed and tabled Section 3.12.

The GCCC updated Section 3.10(a)

The GCCC decided to add a Section 6.08 to address the office of Constable.

Commissioner made a motion to just have one or two sentences describing the office of Constable.

Chairman Cobble seconded the motion.

The GCCC voted 5-2 in favor of this proposal.

Commissioner Johnson reviewed Article 10 and the GCCC finished Article 10.

Commissioner Davenport made a motion to adjourn.

Chairman *Pro Tem* Wood seconded the motion.

The GCCC voted unanimously to adjourn.
