The Greene County Legislative Body met in called session on Tuesday, March 25, 2014 at the Greene County Courthouse.

Mayor Broyles called the meeting to order to transact business that is to lawfully come before this Honorable Body. Commissioner Seay led the Pledge to the Flag, followed by Prayer led by Commissioner Rollins. The Commissioners signed in by roll call vote and the following Commissioners were present: Commissioners Bird; Bowers, Carter, Crum, Dabbs, Greenway, Holt, Hopson, Kiker, King, Malone, McAmis, Moss, Quillen, Rollins, Sams, Sauceman, Seay, Waddle and White were present. Commissioner Hensley was absent. There were 20 Commissioners present and 1 absent.

## NOMINATION OF GREENE COUNTY CLERK

Commissioner Seay made the motion to nominate Janie Fincher as Greene County Clerk. Commissioner Greenway seconded the motion. Commissioner Quillen then nominated Gail Jeffers as Greene County Clerk. Commissioner Moss seconded the nomination. Commissioner Sams moved that all nominations cease. All commissioners agreed. The following vote was taken by roll call: Commissioners Bird, Bowers, Carter, Crum, Dabbs, Greenway, Hopson, Rollins, Sauceman, Sams, Seay, and Waddle voted to appoint Janie Fincher. Commissioners Kiker, King, Malone, McAmis, Moss, Quillen, and White voted to appoint Gail Jeffers. Commissioner Holt abstained. Commissioner Hensley was absent. The vote was 12 – Janie Fincher; 7 – Gail Jeffers; 1 – abstain; 1 – absent. Janie Fincher was then sworn in as Greene County Clerk by Mayor Alan Broyles.
