- WHEREAS, Section 16-117 directs that revenue collected for data entry by the Circuit Court Clerk pursuant to Section 8-21-401, Tennessee Code Annotated to be "allocated by the clerk's county for computerization, information system and electronic records management costs of the clerk's office, including, but not limited to the purchase, upgrade, and maintenance costs of computer equipment, document imagining equipment, and related software and supplies, services, training, and personnel costs related to the computerization, information system and electronic records management", and
- whereas, the Greene County Circuit and Sessions' Office has 15 computers that need to be replaced because the operating system for those computers is Windows XP. Microsoft will no longer provide support, assistance or security updates for Windows XP as of April 8th, 2014, and
- whereas, the lack of support, assistance or security updates for those 15 computers will make those computers more vulnerable to security risks and viruses. In addition, new hardware devices, such as printers, scanners, etc., may not be compatible with these older computers; and
- WHEREAS, during the budget process it was unanticipated that the support for Windows XP would cease, and
- WHEREAS, the Circuit Court Clerk wishes to use \$66,000 of this reserve, and,

Those offices and their needs are: Animal Control one (1) computer at an estimated cost of \$1,425; Veteran's Service Office one (1) computer estimated cost of \$1,375; Inspection and Regulation Office two (2) computers estimated cost of \$2,735; and the Election Office three (3) computers estimated cost of \$4,050 for a total cost of \$9,585; and

- whereas, the lack of support, assistance or security updates for those computers will make those computers more vulnerable to security risks and viruses. In addition, new hardware devices, such as printers, scanners, etc., may not be compatible with these older computers; and
- WHEREAS, during the budget process it was unanticipated that the support for Windows XP would cease, and these offices do not have available funds to provide for these necessary improvements to the computer systems of Greene County, and

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2014 FISCAL YEAR GREENE COUNTY HIGHWAY FUND'S BUDGET TO BUDGET \$2,750 FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO (2) COMPUTERS, AND RELATED SOFTWARE PLUS \$30,000 INCREASE IN THE PIPE-METAL LINE ITEM FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$32,750 FROM THE HIGHWAY FUND BALANCE

- whereas, various offices in Greene County Highway Office has two computers that need to be replaced because the operating system for those computers is Windows XP. Microsoft will no longer provide support, assistance or security updates for Windows XP as of April 8th, 2014. The estimated cost of these computers is \$2,750, and
- whereas, the lack of support, assistance or security updates for this computer will make this computer more vulnerable to security risks and viruses. In addition, new hardware devices, such as printers, scanners, etc., may not be compatible with these older computers; and
- WHEREAS, during the budget process it was unanticipated that the support for Windows XP would cease, and this office does not have available funds to provide for these necessary improvements to the computer system of Greene County Highway Fund, and
- whereas, the Greene County Highway Department has had to replace more tile during paving than in past years and has nearly exhausted the original amount budgeted for this line item. In addition to that fact is that we are entering the spring season for paving and anticipate that many more roads scheduled for paving from now until the end of June will also require tiles to be replaced, and

WHEREAS, the anticipated cost for the additional replacement tiles will be \$30,000, and

THEREFORE, let the Greene County Highway Fund Budget be amended as follows:

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2014 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL FUND'S BUDGET TO PROVIDE FUNDS TOTALING \$2,425 FROM THE GENERAL FUND'S UNASSIGNED FUND BALANCE TO HAVE A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF THE GREENE COUNTY TELEPHONE SYSTEM TO DETERMINE IF A NEW VOICE OVER IP TELEPHONE SYSTEM WOULD REDUCE THE COSTS OF COMMUNICATION FOR GREENE COUNTY

- WHEREAS, Greene County does not have an all-inclusive telephone system and the current ones in place range in age from 8 to 16 years old, utilizing outdated technology, and
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to have an evaluation on said telephone systems to determine if a new telephone system could provide a cost savings and increased efficiency of operation in communication, and
- WHEREAS, in addition to technical and financial feasibility, it is important to implement a system to increase the proficiency of employees to provide better customer service for Greene County residence, and
- WHEREAS, Voice over IP is a mechanism through which Greene County could be very effective in helping its citizens utilize all the resources available to them through an all-inclusive telephone system, and
- WHEREAS, Determining technical and financial feasibility requires obtaining and analyzing data as well as on site evaluations and interviewing personnel to determine support for an all-inclusive telephone system, and
- WHEREAS, Greene County is only participating in a feasibility study and not obligating for an expenditure of General Funds unless separately authorized in a future action by the County Legislative Body.
