whereas, the lack of support, assistance or security updates for this computer will make this computer more vulnerable to security risks and viruses. In addition, new hardware devices, such as printers, scanners, etc., may not be compatible with these older computers; and

WHEREAS, during the budget process it was unanticipated that the support for Windows XP would cease, and this office does not have available funds to provide for these necessary improvements to the computer system of Greene County Highway Fund, and

whereas, the Greene County Highway Department has had to replace more tile during paving than in past years and has nearly exhausted the original amount budgeted for this line item. In addition to that fact is that we are entering the spring season for paving and anticipate that many more roads scheduled for paving from now until the end of June will also require tiles to be replaced, and

WHEREAS, the anticipated cost for the additional replacement tiles will be \$30,000, and THEREFORE, let the Greene County Highway Fund Budget be amended as follows:

A motion was made by Commissioner Greenway and seconded by Commissioner Sams to approve a resolution to amend the 2014 fiscal year Greene County Highway Fund's budget to budget \$2,750 for the purchase of two (2) computers, and related software plus \$30,000 increase in the pipe-metal line item for a total amount of \$32,750 from the Highway fund balance. Mayor Broyles called on the Commissioners to vote on their keypads. - WHEREAS, Greene County does not have an all-inclusive telephone system and the current ones in place range in age from 8 to 16 years old, utilizing outdated technology, and
- whereas, it is in the best interest of the County to have an evaluation on said telephone systems to determine if a new telephone system could provide a cost savings and increased efficiency of operation in communication, and
- whereas, in addition to technical and financial feasibility, it is important to implement a system to increase the proficiency of employees to provide better customer service for Greene County residence, and
- WHEREAS, Voice over IP is a mechanism through which Greene County could be very effective in helping its citizens utilize all the resources available to them through an all-inclusive telephone system, and
- WHEREAS, Determining technical and financial feasibility requires obtaining and analyzing data as well as on site evaluations and interviewing personnel to determine support for an all-inclusive telephone system, and
- WHEREAS, Greene County is only participating in a feasibility study and not obligating for an expenditure of General Funds unless separately authorized in a future action by the County Legislative Body.
