GCCC Meeting Minutes November 20, 2014

Commissioner Johnson led a discussion on Article 10 of the Charter and stated that he would like some time to reconcile two different drafts of this Article.

Secretary Houser led a discussion on Article 13 of the Charter and presented a draft of Article 13 for the GCCC to review.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to accept Article 13. Commissioner Davenport seconded the motion. The GCCC voted unanimously to accept this draft with a few revisions.

Commissioner Johnson made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Claiborne seconded the motion. The GCCC voted unanimously to adjourn.
