Greene County Charter Commission Meeting Minutes

The GCCC held its September 04 meeting at the Greene County Courthouse Annex. All seven commissioners were present.

Chairman Cobble opened in prayer and then called the meeting to order.

Secretary Houser had forgotten to bring the minutes from the August 21 meeting.

Secretary Houser read the minutes from the August 07 meeting.

Chairman Pro Tem Wood made a motion to accept the minutes from the August 07 meeting.

Commissioner Davenport seconded the motion.

The GCCC voted unanimously to accept the August 07 minutes.

Chairman Cobble made a motion to ask the Greene County Commission in their October meeting for a nine month extension.

Chairman *Pro Tem* Wood seconded the motion.

Chairman Cobble amended the motion to add a clause in the request for an extension that would state that the GCCC is not asking for more money just time.

Commissioner Claiborne amended the motion further to get one or more of the GCCC members added to the County Commission meeting agenda to give an update on the progress of the Charter.

The GCCC voted unanimously to accept the motion and amendments to the motion.

Secretary Houser made a motion that the GCCC set September 13 as the scheduled workday on the charter and that the GCCC meet at 9:00 A.M.

Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion.

The GCCC voted unanimously to set September 13 as the workday.

The GCCC started working on the Charter and worked through 2.03, 2.04, 2.05, 2.06, 3.01, 3.02, 3.03, 3.04, and 3.05.

Secretary Houser made a motion to adjourn.

Chairman *Pro Tem* Wood seconded the motion.

Chairman Cobble stated that he would like to conclude the work on Article 3.05 before the GCCC adjourned.

No votes were cast and the GCCC finished the work on 3.05.

Chairman *Pro Tem* Wood made a motion to adjourn.

Commissioner Waddle seconded the motion.

The GCCC Voted unanimously to adjourn.
