## Greene County Charter Commission Meeting Minutes

The GCCC held a workday on Saturday September 13 in the conference room located in the Greene County Courthouse Annex. All seven Commissioners were present.

Chairman Cobble opened in prayer and called the meeting to order

Secretary Houser read the minutes from the August 21 meeting Commissioner Davenport made a motion to accept the minutes from the August 21 meeting. Chair Pro Tem Wood seconded the motion.
The GCCC voted unanimously to accept the minutes.
Secretary Houser read the minutes from the September 04 meeting.
Commissioner Waddle made a motion to accept the minutes from September 04 meeting. Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion.
The GCCC voted unanimously to accept the minutes.
The GCCC started work on the Charter.
Chairman Cobble made a motion to set certain Articles and Sections to a list to revisit. Commissioner Waddle seconded the motion.
The GCCC voted to move troublesome issues to a list to revisit.

At 12:00 noon Chairman Cobble recessed the GCCC until 1:00P.M. for lunch. After lunch Chairman Cobble had a speaking engagement so Chairman Pro Tempore Wood moderated the meeting.

The working draft of the Charter reflects the changes made by the GCCC.
Commissioner Waddle made a motion to adjourn.
Commissioner Johnson seconded the motion.
The GCCC voted unanimously to adjourn.


The list of items to revisit is as follows: Articles 1.02(31), 2.06, 3.03(Residence Issues), 3.14(Petitions, Recalls, Etc.) 4.03(f.)

The other item to redress is the reference to constitutional Tennessee Law.
The Articles that were changed or were adopted as they were are as follows: Articles 3(with the exception of3.03 and 3.14), Article 4 [with the exception of 4.03(f)], Article 7, and Article 12.
It was decided that Article 3.04(Holding More than One Compensated Government Office) would be moved to Article 9 and Article 4.03(h)2 would be moved to Article 5.
