Being the same property identified as Greene County tax map 100, as parcel 38.02, as shown on the map.


This change shall take effect after its passage, the welfare of the County requiring it.

### **Background Field Notes:**

- Property fronts on two roads. Erwin Highway being classified as an arterial road. Moon Creek Road being classified as a local street/minor street. Most often minor streets are intended for limited capacities, carrying traffic for short distances, and serving residential uses. The Erwin Highway transitions from a 4 lane down to a 2 lane at this location. Moon Creek Road is approximately 12 feet in width with a chip and tar surface. Existing utility poles may obstruct entering from the Erwin Highway location therefore forcing traffic onto Moon Creek Road, a less than standard road. Therefore, resulting in concerns of safety for traffic entering and exiting this location. Commercial development should be approved only in those areas where adequate infrastructure is available to support such development.
- Greene County should utilize its regional planning authority to strongly influence planning of development in its defined Rural Areas as per the Greene County 1101 map.
- The current zones in the area of Greene County are A-1 General Agriculture District. The current zones in the area of Tusculum are R-1 Low Density Residential.
- Proposed use is inconsistent with the surrounding area. Current uses in the area are residential and agriculture.



# RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING GREENE COUNTY TO ASSUME AND RELIEVE THE GREENE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION FROM PAYING FROM ITS BEP FUNDS THAT PORTION OF THE BOND PAYMENT OTHERWISE OBLIGATED BY THE GREENE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$58,717.78

WHEREAS, previously as per an agreement between the Greene County Legislative Body and the Greene County Board of Education, the Greene County Board of Education had pledged sales tax revenues generated from the ¼ cent local option increase in the sales tax approved by referendum on March 14, 2000 and up to \$250,000.00 of BEP funding to facilitate construction of Chuckey Doak High School and Mosheim Middle School; and

WHEREAS, in March of 2004, the Greene County Legislative Body authorized Greene County to assume liability for that portion of the pledge in BEP funds obligated by the Board of Education of up to \$250,000.00 to allow the Greene County Board of Education to fund the construction project at Ottway Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the repayment of funds pursuant to the pledge by the Greene County Board of Education was forgiven for a period of 6 years through June 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the agreement between the Board of Education and the Greene County Legislative Body, the Board of Education is now obligated to pay \$58,717.78 to the Greene County Education Debt Service Fund as of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, which represents the Board of Education's pledge of BEP funds pursuant to the agreement between the Greene County Board of Education and the Greene County Legislative Body in 2001; and

WHEREAS, considering the economic downturn and the loss of sales tax revenue, it appears that it would be in the best interest of the Greene County Board of Education as well as Greene County as a whole for the County Legislative Body to forgive the Board of Education's

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obligation of \$58,717.78 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, pursuant to the pledge of BEP funds as described in the agreement between the Board of Education and Greene County in 2001.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Greene County Legislative Body, meeting in regular session on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2011, a quorum being present and a majority voting in the affirmative, that the Greene County Board of Education's obligation of \$58,717.78 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 is forgiven by Greene County Legislative Body and held for nothing with that portion of the Board of Education's obligation to be taken from the County's Education Debt Service Fund Balance.

#### GREENE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION AGREEMENT

### WITH THE GREENE COUNTY LEGISLATURE BODY

In August of 2001, the Greene County Board of Education pledged revenues from a %-cent local option sales tax increase (which was passed by referendum on March 14, 2000) and a contribution of *up to \$250,000*, annually, of BEP funding into the Education Debt Service Fund. The purpose of this pledge was to provide for assistance with debt payments on the \$18,000,000 construction bond issued for the construction projects of Chuckey Doak High School and Mosheim Middle School. This original resolution, approved by the Board of Education and Greene County Legislative Body, is vague as how the up to \$250,000 amount is to be calculated.

The obligation to repay up to \$250,000 annually on debt was forgiven in March of 2004, by action of the Greene County Commission, for a period of 6 years in order that the Board of Education would have funds to construct a project at Ottway Elementary. The fiscal year ending June 30, 2010 was the first year in which the Board of Education was to resume payments.

After researching the original resolution and the resolution to forgive payments for six years and after consulting with current and past officials, it became clear that there is no consensus of how the calculation of amount due from the Board of Education is to be performed. Those officials maintain that the original intent of the resolutions was to require payments from the Board of Education in order to maintain a \$1,000,000 fund balance in the Education Debt Service Fund.

The resolution presented for your consideration in this packet will allow the amount due from the Board of Education as of June 30, 2010 to be forgiven. This resolution is necessary in order to allow additional time for the Greene County Legislative Body and the Greene County Board of Education to formulate a plan, in plain English, that will clearly explain how the amount due on the Board of Education's obligation to the Education Debt Service Fund will be calculated in future years.

The resolution was reviewed by Mr. Mark Treece, county audit supervisor, and was approved by both the Greene County Education Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee.
