



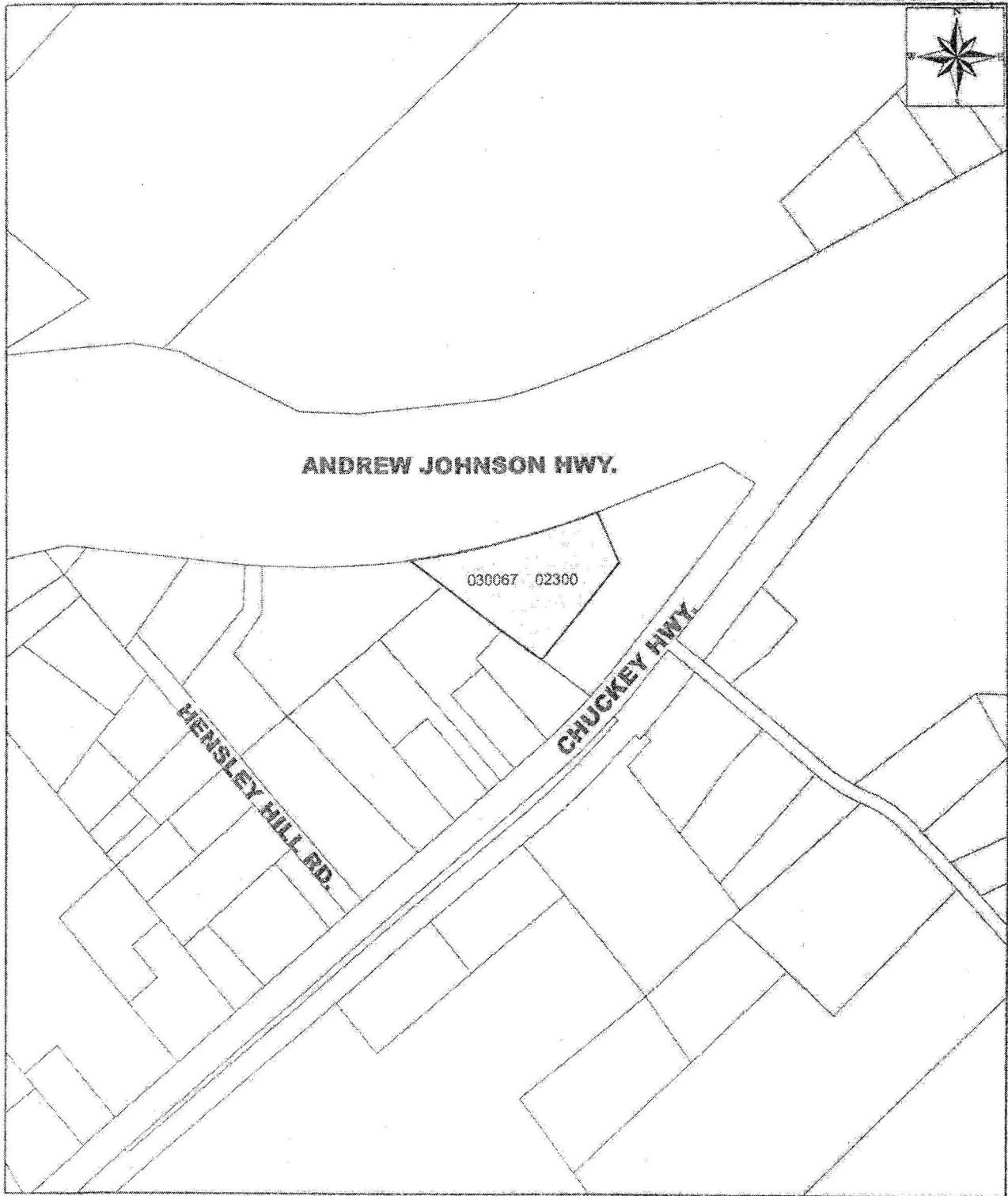

**RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER FUNDS FROM GENERAL PURPOSE SCHOOL FUNDS TO
FEDERAL PROJECTS FUND FOR FISCAL YEAR ENDINIG JUNE 30, 2011**

WHEREAS, Federal Projects grants operate on a reimbursement basis and funds are requested from the State of Tennessee by Greene County School District for non-payroll expenditures on a monthly basis; and,

WHEREAS, the Federal Projects Fund operates with a cash deficit at various times throughout the fiscal year due to a slow turn-around time for reimbursements from the State of Tennessee; and,

WHEREAS, Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) consider a cash deficit in any fund to be a significant deficiency in internal controls; and,

WHEREAS, Greene County School District does not desire to operate any fund with a cash deficit.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of Greene County School District, a school district in Tennessee, meeting in called session on this 26th day of August, 2010 authorized and approved the following:

SECTION 1. The General Purpose School Fund shall loan \$200,000 to the Federal Projects Fund on September 20, 2010.

SECTION 2. The \$200,000 loan shall remain in the Federal Projects Fund as a designated fund balance from the General Purpose School Fund and may be repaid at any time as noted in a resolution passed by the Board of Education and County Commission.



**A RESOLUTION TO REMOVE A PORTION OF MCCULLOUGH LANE FROM

WHEREAS, McCullough Lane is a dead end road, .3 mile in length beginning at Gap Creek Rd. and is located in the 19th Civil District of Greene County, Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, after a review of this road by the Road Committee for the Greene County Legislative Body, it appears that the portion of McCullough Lane at its end consisting of approximately .14 mile should be removed from the official Greene County Road List; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Highway Department will be relieved of the responsibility for the portion of McCullough Lane that is being removed and for its maintenance and the new length of the county road will be .16 mile.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Greene County Legislative Body meeting in regular session on the 20th day of September, 2010, a quorum being present and a majority voting in the affirmative, that the portion of .14 mile at the end of McCullough Lane shall be removed from the official Greene County Road List and the new length of McCullough Lane will be .16 mile.
