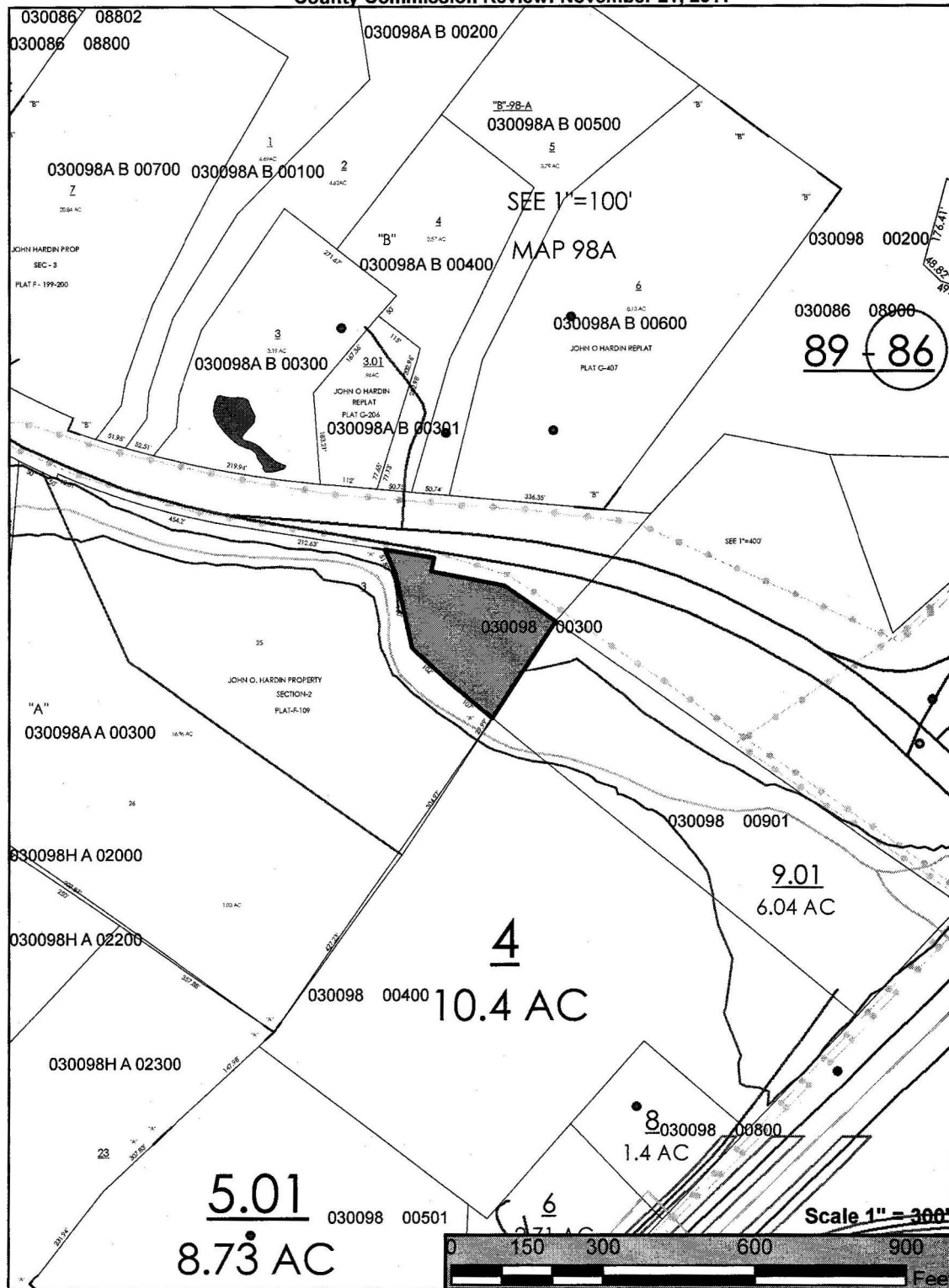

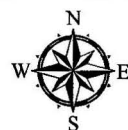

**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2012 FISCAL YEAR
GENERAL FUND'S BUDGET TO BUDGET FOR MENTAL HEALTH
EVALUATION AND TREATMENT SERVICES ORDERED BY JUDGES**

WHEREAS, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 33-7-304(a) makes counties responsible for the cost of outpatient and inpatient mental health evaluations and treatment court ordered for defendants charged only with misdemeanors if such defendants are unable to pay for these services; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County General Sessions Judge has ordered two defendants to undergo these mental health evaluations and treatment; and

WHEREAS, during the budget process it was unanticipated that the cost of treatment would exceed previous expenditures as the budget was based on historical costs;

THEREFORE, let the General Fund budget be amended as follows:

**RESOLUTION TO BUDGET FOR A CONTRIBUTION TO THE
GUS MACKER COMMUNITY BASKETBALL TOURNAMENT
FROM THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUND**

WHEREAS, the Greene County Partnership has signed a contract with Gus Macker Basketball, LLC to host a Gus Macker Basketball Community Tournament on June 23 and June 24 of 2012. This tournament will be hosted for three years per this contract. This is a 3-on-3 tournament that is open to teams of all ages; and

WHEREAS, This tournament will generate a significant economic impact to the county as this will be the only Gus Macker Basketball Community Tournament held in Tennessee during June 2012; and

WHEREAS, this tournament will allow local and regional teams to participate in a wholesome, family-oriented event; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Partnership has already incurred expenses related to this even and request that the Greene County Commission make a contribution of \$10,000 to help defray the costs of sponsoring this event,

WHEREAS, the Greene County hotel/motel tax was adopted to help fund recreational pursuits in Greene County and the Greene County Legislature does wish to contribute to this event and that said funding be derived and taken from the portion of the hotel/motel tax allocated for the recreational pursuits for Greene County; and

THEREFORE, let the Economic Development Fund budget be amended as follows:

**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPTING A DEBT
MANAGEMENT POLICY FOR GREENE COUNTY**

WHEREAS, *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 9-21-151(b)(1), authorizes the State Funding Board to develop model financial transaction policies for local governments and local government instrumentalities;

WHEREAS, the State Funding Board has adopted a statement on debt management and directed local governments and government entities that borrow money to draft their own debt management policies with certain mandatory provisions; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Legislative Body has prepared a debt management policy that includes the mandatory provisions relative to transparency, professionals and conflicts.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Greene County Legislative Body meeting in regular session this 21st day of November, 2011, a quorum being present and a majority voting in the affirmative, that:

SECTION 1. The debt management policy attached as Exhibit A to this resolution, incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect upon passage, the public welfare requiring it.
