## A RESOLUTION OF THE GREENE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY TO CORRECT THE GENERAL SESSIONS COURT JUDGE SALARY FOR FYE JUNE 30, 2018

**WHEREAS**, the Greene County General Sessions Court Judge is required to have their salary increased by the actual percentage change in the consumer price index between the previous two years (T.C.A. §§ 16-15-5003 and 8-23-103) and;

WHEREAS, in FY 2016, the CPI had not been calculated by the time the budget was passed and an increase of 0.8% was used when the actual CPI was 1.6% and;

WHEREAS, this created a variance of one thousand two hundred eighty-nine dollars (\$1,289) in salary and one hundred seventy-nine dollars (\$179) in taxes and benefits and;
