Listed below is the iVotronic Voting Machine Instructions:

Instructions for voting on the iVotronic Machines applies to each Ballot:

To select your candidate, touch the candidate's name on the screen, to de-select, touch box again. The iVotronic will not allow you to vote for more people than may be elected to any one office.

- 1. Touch "Next" in the lower right corner to navigate forward through the ballot.
- 2. Touch "Back" in the lower left corner to navigate backward through the ballot.
- 3. After completing last ballot page, touch "Review" and carefully review the selection review screen.
 - To change or make a new choice, touch box next to candidate or office name and then touch box next to new selection.
- 4. When finished, press either the flashing red "Vote" button or the flashing green box with a check mark saying "Press here to cast your Ballot".
- 5. When the next screen appears, press "Confirm"
- 6. "Your Ballot has been Cast" "Thank You for Voting" screen means you have properly cast your ballot.

PHOTO ID REQUIRED FOR VOTERS: If you are voting in person during Early Voting or on Election Day, a federal or State of Tennessee Government issued photo ID is required for voting, unless an exception applies. College student ID's and out-of-state photo ID's will not be accepted. Forms of acceptable identification, even if expired, include a Tennessee driver license with your photo, United States passport, Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security photo ID, Photo ID issued by the federal government, United States military ID including a Veteran Identification Card, and a Tennessee handgun carry permit with your photo.
