WHEREAS, the Greeneville/Greene County Emergency Medical Service (EMS) has a 1996 International 4700 truck VIN #1HTSCAAM2TH230994 that the Service can no longer utilize because of its age and condition; and

WHEREAS, the Greene County Chaplain's Association, a non-profit organization is in need of a vehicle to use as a mobile command post; and
