State/Federal Republican and Democratic August Primary, Independent Candidates for the November General Election, August County General Election & Town of Baileyton, Town of Greeneville, & Town of Mosheim Municipal Elections

To the voters of Greene County, TN, you are hereby notified pursuant to TCA 2-12-111(a), that a **State/Federal Republican and Democratic Primary Election, and County General Election** will be held in all voting precincts in Greene County, TN, on **Thursday, August 6, 2020**, for the offices listed below. In addition, there will be a **Municipal Election for the Town of Baileyton, Town of Greeneville, and Town of Mosheim** for the offices listed below.

Any other office or question that may timely qualify to appear on the ballot.	

County General Election

(These offices are non-partisan)

School Board Member (2nd School Board District) one seat	4-year term
School Board Member (7th School Board District) one seat	4-year term
Any other office or question that may timely qualify to appear on the ballot.	

Please Note: The following office will also appear on the County General Election Ballot. The deadline to qualify by petition for this office was December 12, 2019, at 12:00 Noon.

Any other office or question that may timely qualify to appear on the ballot.	

Town of Greeneville - Municipal Election

(These offices are non-partisan)

Mayor-at-Large	2-year term
Alderman-2nd Ward (2) two seats	2-year term
School Board Member-2nd Ward (2) two seats	4-year term
Any other office or question that may appear on the ballot	

Town of Mosheim - Municipal Election

(These offices are non-partisan)

Mayor-at-Large	4-year term
Alderman-1st Ward (1) one seat	4-year term
Alderman-2nd Ward (1) one seat	4-year term
Any other office or question that may timely qualify to appear on the ballot.	

- **February 3, 2020** was the first day a candidate for the August State/Federal Primary Election and Independent candidates for the November General Election could pick-up a nominating petition for the offices of **United States Senate, United States House of Representatives & Tennessee House of Representative**.
- The first day candidates for the County General, Town of Baileyton Municipal Election, Town of Greeneville Municipal Election, and Town of Mosheim Municipal Election may pick-up a nominating petition was **February 3, 2020**.
- Qualifying deadline will be **Thursday, April 2, 2020, at 12:00 NOON** for all candidates. TCA 2-5-101(a)
- **Candidates for Statewide Office** must file their original nominating petitions in the office of the State Election Commission, a certified duplicate petition in the office of the Coordinator of Elections and a certified duplicate petition with the chairperson of their party's state executive committee by **Thursday, April 2, 2020, at 12:00 NOON**. TCA 2-5-101(a)
- **Other State Primary and Independent Candidates** must file their original nominating petition in the Election Commission Office of their county of residence and certified duplicate copies of their petition

in each county wholly or partially within the candidate's district by **Thursday, April 2, 2020, at NOON.** TCA 2-5-101(a)

- The Withdrawal Deadline will be **Thursday, April 9, 2020, at 12:00 NOON.** TCA 2-5-204 (b) (1)
- The last day to register to vote in person or by mail postmark for the August Primary and General Election will be **Tuesday, July 7, 2020.** TCA 2-2-109

Public Notice for Elderly Voters or Voters with Disabilities

Any elderly voter or voter with a disability whose polling place is inaccessible may vote early by absentee ballot or at the Election Commission Office on Election Day. TCA 2-3-109 (e) (1)

If voters choose to vote at the Election Commission Office on Election Day, they must complete an affidavit at the Election Commission Office **no later than July 27, 2020, ten days prior to the election**, stating that their designated voting location is inaccessible. For more information, please contact the Greene County Election Commission office.

PHOTO ID REQUIRED FOR VOTERS: If you are voting in person during Early Voting or on Election Day, a Federal or State of Tennessee Government issued **photo ID** is required for voting, unless an exception applies. College student ID's and out-of-state photo ID's will not be accepted. Forms of acceptable identification, even if expired, include a Tennessee driver license with your photo, United States passport, Tennessee Department of Safety and Homeland Security photo ID, Photo ID issued by the federal government, United States military ID including a Veteran Identification Card, and a Tennessee handgun carry permit with your photo.
