OLD BUSINESS

Mayor Morrison announced the second Greene County Citizen Hero Medal Award to Jada Tweed, a senior at North Greene High School, whose car caught on fire at the Pilot Travel Center in Baileyton. She exercised her courage and bravery by evacuating her siblings, who were sleeping in the back seat, from the vehicle. She alerted the fire station and the people close by to move away from the fire. She also turned off the gas pumps at the gas station. She was presented the Greene County Citizen Hero Medal Award and the Pilot Corporation presented her with a new vehicle.

Mayor Morrison also recognized Beth Wilhoit and was presented with a Greene County Citizen Hero Medal for her actions during a multiple injury car accident on 11-E on October 21, 2021. Beth Wilhoit, a health care worker, stopped when she saw the accident and provided lifesaving assistance to an accident victim, including applying a tourniquet to the victim's leg, before emergency services arrived. Heather Sipe, Emergency Management Agency Director, and Wesley Holt, Greene County Sheriff, presented the award to Beth Wilhoit.

Only approximately 25 registered voters would move commission districts. Without some moves, voter anonymity cannot be guaranteed on early voting results reported by precincts.

Motion made by Pamela Carpenter and seconded by Kathy Crawford to allow Election Commission to make minor adjustments to voter locations that have been altered due to annexation since the last census affecting 25 registered voters. All in favor. Motion passed

Motion then made by John Waddle and second by Kathy Crawford keeping the 7 Commission districts and their boundaries as they currently are. All in favor. Motion passed.

Motion made by Brad Peters and second by Bill Dabbs to adjourn. Meeting adjourned.

Greene County Commission Education Committee

4 October 2021

Regular Meeting

The Greene County Commission Education Committee met at 3:30 PM at the Greene County Schools Central Office for its regular September meeting.

<u>Committee Members in Attendance</u>: Chairman Bill Dabbs, Dale Tucker, and Paul Burkey. Lloyd Bowers and Tim White were absent. Director David McLain was present as well.

Others in Attendance: Kayla Crawford, Chris Malone, Spencer Morrell (Greeneville Sun)

The Committee reviewed the minutes from the 30 Aug meeting. Mr. Tucker made the motion to accept the minutes. Mr. Burkey seconded. The motion to approve passed 3-0.

Mr. McLain, Ms. Crawford and Mr. Malone presented for approval and explained a draft resolution to move \$500,000 from the Greene County Schools General Fund 141 to the Federal Projects Fund 142 as a "revolving" account to provide a higher cashflow buffer for covering Federal Projects expenses while the School System waits for reimbursement from the Federal Government through the State Dept of Education. This would augment the \$200,000 already in Fund 142 for that purpose to make a total of \$700,000. The additional funding is required to prevent cash deficits as the system processes much larger expenditures coming from Federal Recovery Act and ESSER Funding. Mr. Burkey moved to recommend approval. Mr. Tucker Seconded. The motion passed 3-0.

Mr. McLain reviewed initial Average Daily Membership (ADM) numbers for 2021-2022. They are up 28 students from 2020-2021 but still about 52 below the 2019 "Hold Harmless" population the State will use as it calculates BEP funding next year. While he is concerned that the end of the "Hold Harmless" period will result in a reduction in BEP funding of around \$800,000, he is hopeful that will be off-set somewhat by a State-planned increase in nursing and counseling support as well as assistant principals in schools would result in an increase to reflect those newly mandated requirements. He and several area school administrators met with 8 legislators recently (David Hawk was one of them), where he and others emphasized these concerns.

Mr. McLain provided an explanation of the Greene County Schools TVAAS Growth and Achievement results based on Spring 2021 student testing. He also provided a tutorial on the impacts of the pandemic on testing scores as well as the trade-offs in prioritizing growth or achievement goals. Growth scoring was affected in some schools because, as a result of COVID, there were no third grade assessments to compare with last Spring's fifth grade testing. He also pointed out the very positive outcomes in system-wide growth, especially at the Middle School level.

Meeting adjourned.

The next Education Committee meeting will be at 3:30 PM on Monday, 1 November.

A RESOLUTION OF THE GREENE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY APPROVING THE USE OF THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN FUNDING FOR PROJECT "C" FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2022

WHEREAS, Greene County has been allocated approximately thirteen million four hundred fifteen thousand eight hundred forty-four dollars (\$13,415,844) in American Rescue Plan Funding (ARP), and;

WHEREAS, Project "C" - The Interim Final Rule (Rule) allows ARP funding to be used for Water and Sewer Infrastructure. As defined in the Rule, Water and Sewer Infrastructure can be "The ARPA provides funds to State, local, and Tribal governments to make necessary investments in water and sewer infrastructure. By permitting funds to be used for water and sewer infrastructure needs, Congress recognized the critical role that clean drinking water and services for the collection and treatment of wastewater and stormwater play in protecting public health. Understanding that State, local, and Tribal governments have a broad range of water and sewer infrastructure needs, the Interim Final Rule provides these governments with wide latitude to identify investments in water and sewer infrastructure that are of the highest priority for their own communities, which may include projects on privately-owned infrastructure. The Interim Final Rule does this by aligning eligible uses of the Fiscal Recovery Funds with the wide range of types or categories of projects that would be eligible to receive financial assistance through the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) or Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF)." Greene County requests approval to use approximately four million ninety thousand four hundred twenty-eight (\$4,090,428) dollars in ARP funding. In addition, Greene County will tentatively have access to an amount included in the anticipated State of Tennessee match, calculated in the program summary draft as follows "Each county will be eligible to receive a base allocation plus a portion of monies determined based on county population. The formula that will be used follows. 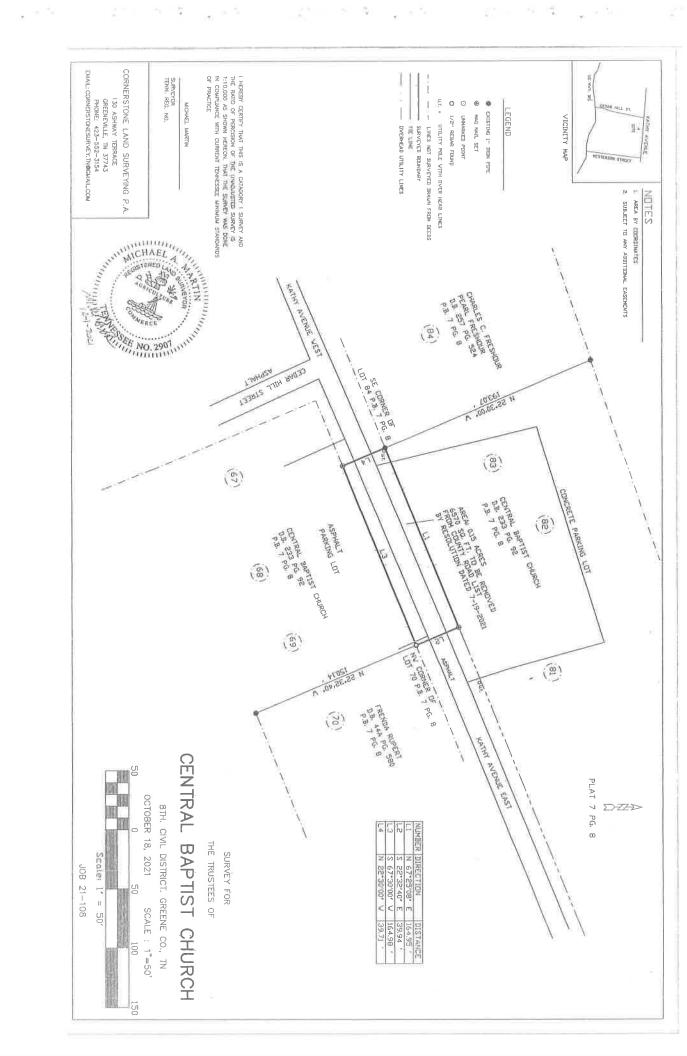

RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE REDISTRICTING PLAN FOR GREENE COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-1-111, requires that, at least every ten (10) years, county legislative bodies shall change the boundaries of districts or redistrict a county entirely if necessary to apportion the county legislative body so that the members represent substantially equal populations; and

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2021, the Greene County Legislative Body adopted a redistricting plan for Greene County in compliance with *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-111; and

WHEREAS, the adopted redistricting plan was framed to generally permit and allow all town residents to vote at polling locations within the Town and to permit and allow all residents residing in the County outside of the corporate limits of Greeneville to vote at the appropriate polling locations in the County outside the Town of Greeneville; and

WHEREAS, after the redistricting plan for Greene County was adopted, the Administration of Elections discovered that the U. S. Census Bureau had made an error and had mistakenly included two census blocks on Pelican Lane outside Greeneville's corporate limits as being within the corporate limits of the Town of Greeneville; and

WHEREAS, residents in those two census blocks had previously been voting at Glenwood School and upon passage of this amended redistricting plan will continue to vote at Glenwood School; and

WHEREAS, the Election Commission with the assistance of the Accessor of Property has corrected the official redistricting map for Greene County to place the two census blocks on Pelican Lane as shown on the map (attached as "Exhibit A") in Commission District 7 as opposed to Commission District 5; and

WHEREAS, Greene County has prepared an amended redistricting plan consistent with the provisions of *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-111, and the corrected U. S. census maps which provides for a County Legislative Body composed of twenty-one (21) members, which creates seven (7) districts as depicted on the official redistricting map for Greene County prepared pursuant to *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-110, and provides that three commissioners be elected from each district; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to *Tennessee Code Annotated, Section* 49-2-201(a)(1), the County Legislative Body for Greene County is required to establish districts of substantially equal population for the election of members of the County Board of Education; and



WHEREAS, Greene County has prepared an amended plan consistent with the provisions of *Tennessee Code Annotated*, *Section 49-2-201-(a)(1)*, which provides for a Board of Education consisting of seven (7) members and which creates seven (7) districts with one member of the school board elected from each district; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-10-101(b)(1), the County Legislative Body is required to establish constable districts with the number of constables to be elected not to exceed one-half (1/2) of the number of county commissioners and in establishing constable districts, population may be determined in the manner used to establish county commissioner district; and

WHEREAS, Greene County has prepared an amended plan consistent with the provisions of *Tennessee Code Annotated*, *Section 8-10-101(b)(1)* which provides and creates seven (7) constable districts with one (1) constable to be elected by popular vote from each district as depicted on the official redistricting plan for Greene County, prepared and approved by the Redistricting Committee; and

WHEREAS, the school board districts and constable districts above established shall be identical to the commission districts as recommended by the Redistricting Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Greene County Legislative Body meeting in regular session at Greene County, Tennessee, on this the 20th day of December, 2021, that:

SECTION 1. There is hereby an **amended** redistricting plan for Greene County which provides for three (3) commissioners in each of the seven (7) districts for a total County Legislative Body of twenty-one members. The districts for members of the County Legislative Body are depicted on the corrected official redistricting map for Greene County prepared pursuant to *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-110. A copy of the corrected redistricting map, <u>Exhibit B</u>, is attached to this resolution.

SECTION 2. All members of the County Legislative Body shall be elected at large within the district wherein the candidate seeks election. The three candidates receiving the greatest number of votes in each district shall be elected.

SECTION 3. The school board districts, and constable districts shall be identical to the commission districts with one (1) constable elected from each constable district and one (1) member of the board of education elected from each board of education district.

SECTION 4. That any school board member elected to the board of education shall be entitled to serve the remainder of his/her elected term and until his/her successor is seated.

This plan shall take effect upon passage, the public welfare requiring it, provided that vacancies shall be filled in accordance with *Tennessee Code Annotated*, Section 5-1-104.
