PROCLAMATION DECLARING THE WEEK OF FEBRUARY 7-14, 2022 AS CONGENITAL HEART DEFECT AWARENESS WEEK IN GREENE COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS, the health and well-being of congenital heart patients is of paramount importance; and

WHEREAS, each year in the United States, more than 40,000 babies are born with a congenital heart defect; and

WHEREAS, the medical community has identified congenital heart defects as the leading cause of birth defect-related deaths; and

WHEREAS, medical research can provide more identifiable means of the origins and symptoms of congenital heart defects; and

WHEREAS, there is no cure for congenital heart defects, and it is a lifelong disease requiring ongoing specialized care; and

WHEREAS, fewer than 10% of adults with congenital heart disease are receiving recommended care, we must do more to raise awareness for identification, treatment, and lifelong care of congenital heart defects; and

WHEREAS, it is crucial that individuals planning a family, fetal clinicians, obstetric physicians, pediatricians, and all those in the medical field have a greater understanding of the potential for congenital heart defects and assist in educating the greater public about the individual and collective community impact of congenital heart defects; and

WHEREAS, declaring and observing Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week will also provide a firsthand opportunity for patients and families affected by this condition to share their experiences and knowledge as well as the reminders to all the general public; and

THEREFORE, I, Kevin C, Morrison, Mayor of Greene County, do hereby proclaim February 7-14, 2022, *CONGENITAL HEART DEFECT AWARENESS WEEK* and encourage all to join me in this special observance of education and awareness of this too often subdued lifelong medical condition and its impact on our people and our community.

GREENE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY DECEMBER 20, 2021 6:00 P.M.

The Greene County Legislative Body was in regular session on December 20, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. in the Greene County Courthouse.

Mayor Morrison called the meeting to order to transact business that has lawfully come before the Honorable Body. Commissioner Kaleb Powell gave the invocation with a moment of silence for the passing of Commissioner Clifford "Doc" Bryant.

Commissioner George Clemmer led the Pledge to the Flag.

Mayor Morrison called the Commissioners to sign in on their keypads and the following Commissions were present. Commissioners Bible, Bowers, Burkey, Carpenter, Clemmer, Cobble, Dabbs, Kesterson, Lawing, Parton, Peters, Powell, Quillen, Shelton, Tucker, and Waddle were present. Commissioners Arrowood, Crawford, and White were absent. Commissioner Clifford "Doc" Bryant passed away. Commissioner Lane resigned. There were 16 – present and 5 Commissioners absent.

PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Morrison announced there were no speakers for the Public Hearing section.

APPROVAL OF PRIOR MINUTES

A motion was made by Commissioner Quillen and seconded by Commissioner Parton to approve the prior minutes.

Mayor Morrison called the Commissioners to vote on their keypads. The following vote was taken to approve the prior minutes. Commissioners Bible, Bowers, Burkey, Carpenter, Clemmer, Cobble, Dabbs, Kesterson, Lawing, Parton, Powell, Quillen, Shelton, Tucker, and Waddle were present. Commissioner Arrowood, Bryant, Crawford, Lane, and White were absent. Commissioner Peters abstained. The vote was 15 - aye; 0 - nay; 1 - abstained; and 5 - absent. Mayor Morrison stated that the prior minutes were approved.

Peters to approve a Resolution allocating the proceeds from the sale of surplus property

on Gov Deals to the Solid Waste Department.

RESOLUTION B: A RESOLUTION OF THE GREENE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS AND RECOGNIZED REVENUE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$47,065 FOR THE DISPOSITION OF UNSOLD DELINQUENT TAX PROPERTIES OF THE FYE JUNE 30, 2022

Commissioner Dabbs voted no. Commissioners Bryant, Crawford, Lane, and White were absent. The vote was 16 - aye; 1 - nay; and 4 - absent. Commissioner Arrowood joined the Commission Meeting at 6:10 p.m. The motion to approve the Resolution passed.

RESOLUTION D: A RESOLUTION OF THE GREENE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE JAIL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,265 FOR THE REPAYMENT OF THE UNUSED PORTION OF THE MENTAL HEALTH TRANSPORTATION GRANT FOR THE FYE JUNE 30, 2002

A motion was made by Commissioner Quillen and seconded by Commissioner

Lawing to approve a Resolution of the Greene County Legislative Body to appropriated funds
to the Jail in the amount of \$6,265 for the repayment of the unused portion of the Mental Health
Transportation Grant for the FYE June 30, 2022.

RESOLUTION E: A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE \$1,500 TO PURCHASE LAW ENFORCEMENT EQUIPMENT FROM THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT RESTRICTED FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2022

A motion was made by Commissioner Clemmer and seconded by Commissioner Parton to appropriate \$1,500 to purchase law enforcement equipment from the Sheriff's Department Restricted Fund for the Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2022.

RESOLUTION F: A RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE \$42,000 TO PAY FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THE SOFTWARE AND PURCHASE THE EVIDENCE MODULE FOR THE WATSON CLOUD BASED SYSTEM FROM THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT RESTRICTED FUND FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2022

Mayor Morrison announced the vacancy for the 3rd District Commission seat due to the passing of Clifford "Doc" Bryant and the vacancy for the 7th District Commission seat due to resignation of April Lane.

Mayor Morrison stated that resumes can be brought to the Greene County Mayor's Office and then will be forwarded to the Election Commission Office to determine that the applicants do properly reside in those districts and meet the qualifications to serve on the County Commission. The applicants will be contacted to attend the January County Commission Meeting so they may have the opportunity to speak to the Commission.

Commissioner Quillen announced there would be trailers set up at the Greene County

Partnership in the parking lot to collect necessities for the Kentucky communities affected

by the tornados.

The Chairman called the meeting to order and welcomed attendees.

Adoption of Agenda. The Chairman asked for a motion to adopt the agenda. A motion was made by Jason Smith, seconded by Beth Douthat, to adopt the agenda. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u>. The Chairman asked if members had received the draft minutes of the August 31, 2021 meeting. A motion was made by Jason Smith, seconded by David Crum, to approve the minutes as written. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>Swearing in of witnesses</u>. Judy Nelson, Jennifer Sanchez, Richard Nubile, and Tim Tweed, Greene County Building Official, were sworn in.

1334 Smelcer Rd. The Board considered a request by Rich and Linda Nubile to grant a front yard setback variance of 11 feet for 1334 Smelcer Rd. (tax parcel 104-044.22), reducing the requirement from fifty-five (55) feet from centerline of Smelcer Rd. to forty-four (44) feet, to permit construction of a porch. Staff stated the front porch for the mobile home had already been constructed, and intruded eleven (11) feet into the required front yard setback. The Board was informed a 15 degree slope began roughly one foot behind the mobile home, and unless considerable site work was performed the home could not be moved far enough back from the road to meet the setback requirement. Tim Tweed, Greene County Building Commissioner, stated a permit had been obtained for the house construction. Richard Nubil, homeowner, stated he had relied on the builder to know the setback requirements, and spoke in favor of the request. After discussion, a motion was made by David Crum, seconded by Jason Smith, to grant the variance request based on the following rationale:

- 1. The presence of a 15 degree slope behind the home created an exceptional topographical condition or other extraordinary or exceptional situation or condition that would result in exceptional practical difficulties to or exceptional and undue hardship upon the property owners.
- 2. Relief could be granted without substantial detriment to the public good and without substantially impairing the intent and purpose of the zoning resolution.
- 3. The location of the slope was a special circumstance attached to the property which did not generally apply to other property in the neighborhood.

The motion carried unanimously.

2975 N. Wesley Chapel Rd. The Board considered a request by Daniel and Judy Nelson to grant a front yard setback variance of 13 feet for 2975 N. Wesley Chapel Rd. (tax parcels 34-H-A-19, 20, and 21), reducing the requirement from fifty-five (55) feet from the centerline of the road to forty-two (42) feet. Staff stated the proposal was to construct a 30' x 40' garage adjacent to the existing home, angled to where one corner of the garage would be 42 feet from the centerline of N. Wesley Chapel Rd. The Board was informed there was a slope to the rear of the proposed garage location that measured approximately 15 degrees, and substantial site work would have to be performed if the garage were to meet the setback requirement. Judy and Daniel Nelson were present and spoke in favor of the request. After discussion, a motion was made by Beth Douthat, seconded by David Crum, to grant the variance request, based on the following rationale:

- 1. The presence of a 15 degree slope behind the home created an exceptional topographical condition or other extraordinary or exceptional situation or condition that would result in exceptional practical difficulties to or exceptional and undue hardship upon the owners.
- 2. Relief could be granted without substantial detriment to the public good and without substantially impairing the intent and purpose of the zoning resolution.
- 3. The location of the slope was a special circumstance attached to the property which did not generally apply to other property in the neighborhood.

The motion carried unanimously.

5755 Warrensburg Rd. The Board considered a request by Jennifer Sanchez to grant a rear yard setback variance of seven feet for 5755 Warrensburg Rd. (tax parcel 120-082.01), reducing the requirement from thirty (30) feet to twenty-three (23) feet. Staff stated the property was "L" shaped, with slightly less than 100 feet of road frontage. The overall width of the property, including a "dogleg", was approximately 165 feet. The septic system, which had been installed for a previous home, was located in the central front portion of the property, which shifted the buildable area towards the rear of the site. The limitations of the property were such that unless

the variance was granted, the property could not be reasonably used without relocating the septic system. The property owner, Jennifer Sanchez, was present and spoke in favor of the request. After discussion, a motion was made by David Crum, seconded by Jason Smith, to grant the variance request, based on the following rationale:

- 1. The lot had exceptional/extraordinary conditions (shape and size of lot, and location of septic system) that would result in exceptional practical difficulties to or exceptional and undue hardship upon the owner if the variance were not granted, in that additional property would have to be purchased to change the lot size/shape, or the septic system would have to be relocated.
- 2. Relief could be granted without substantial detriment to the public good and without substantially impairing the intent and purpose of the zoning resolution.
- 3. Special circumstances were attached to the property which did not generally apply to other property in the neighborhood, i.e., the shape and size of the property, and location of the septic system limited where a home could be placed.

The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, a motion was made by David Crum, seconded by Jason Smith, to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

The balance will probably decrease after the training is over and the overtime/insurance line will cover that after putting more funds into that line.

Jerry Bird gave the power phone update. The interfaces are testing well and we should be up and running soon.

The training sessions have been hit by Covid for the last 2 weeks, slowing down our completion of that. The 5 new dispatchers have really stepped up to help. We also have 3 police officers that are helping on a part time basis.

The amount for the power phones will be, \$77,400.00. Data Cloud back up will be \$10,300.00 with the cost of the primary back up box being \$1,545.00. Committee voted to go ahead and pay for power phones out of our budget. We will then ask commission for reimbursement.

Greene County Commission Education Committee

4 October 2021

Regular Meeting

The Greene County Commission Education Committee met at 3:30 PM at the Greene County Schools Central Office for its regular September meeting.

<u>Committee Members in Attendance</u>: Chairman Bill Dabbs, Dale Tucker, and Paul Burkey. Lloyd Bowers and Tim White were absent. Director David McLain was present as well.

Others in Attendance: Kayla Crawford, Chris Malone, Spencer Morrell (Greeneville Sun)

The Committee reviewed the minutes from the 30 Aug meeting. Mr. Tucker made the motion to accept the minutes. Mr. Burkey seconded. The motion to approve passed 3-0.

Mr. McLain, Ms. Crawford and Mr. Malone presented for approval and explained a draft resolution to move \$500,000 from the Greene County Schools General Fund 141 to the Federal Projects Fund 142 as a "revolving" account to provide a higher cashflow buffer for covering Federal Projects expenses while the School System waits for reimbursement from the Federal Government through the State Dept of Education. This would augment the \$200,000 already in Fund 142 for that purpose to make a total of \$700,000. The additional funding is required to prevent cash deficits as the system processes much larger expenditures coming from Federal Recovery Act and ESSER Funding. Mr. Burkey moved to recommend approval. Mr. Tucker Seconded. The motion passed 3-0.

Mr. McLain reviewed initial Average Daily Membership (ADM) numbers for 2021-2022. They are up 28 students from 2020-2021 but still about 52 below the 2019 "Hold Harmless" population the State will use as it calculates BEP funding next year. While he is concerned that the end of the "Hold Harmless" period will result in a reduction in BEP funding of around \$800,000, he is hopeful that will be off-set somewhat by a State-planned increase in nursing and counseling support as well as assistant principals in schools would result in an increase to reflect those newly mandated requirements. He and several area school administrators met with 8 legislators recently (David Hawk was one of them), where he and others emphasized these concerns.

Mr. McLain provided an explanation of the Greene County Schools TVAAS Growth and Achievement results based on Spring 2021 student testing. He also provided a tutorial on the impacts of the pandemic on testing scores as well as the trade-offs in prioritizing growth or achievement goals. Growth scoring was affected in some schools because, as a result of COVID, there were no third grade assessments to compare with last Spring's fifth grade testing. He also pointed out the very positive outcomes in system-wide growth, especially at the Middle School level.

"EXHIBIT A"

Greene County Purchasing Card Policy

The use of purchasing cards is strictly limited to Greene County officials and employees. All purchasing cards must be approved in advance by the Greene County Purchasing Agent. Greene County officials and employees must receive prior approval to use a purchasing card and must sign a Cardholder Agreement before using a Greene County purchasing card.

Applications for purchasing cards must be submitted to the Greene County Purchasing Agent. All applications for issuance of a Greene County purchasing card must be signed by the appropriate county official or department head under whose direction the applicant works.

All purchasing cards will be issued in the name of the individual employee or official or department who is responsible for the use of the card. The card will also have the County's name embossed on the card. The official or employee/department whose name appears on the card is responsible for ensuring that all purchases made using that card are in accordance with all policies, rules and regulations of Greene County.

The person whose name appears on the card may be held personally liable for any unauthorized purchases made with the card, including purchases exceeding the purchasing limits.

Single purchases shall not exceed purchases that require the current amount for competitive bid. Monthly purchasing card total purchases shall not exceed amounts set forth by the Greene County Purchasing Agent.

Each county official or department head will be responsible for ensuring that the purchasing limit is not exceeded in any one month, or for any single purchase, with respect to all purchases using purchasing cards issued to the official or department head and to any employees of that office or department.

All purchases will be reconciled monthly by the person whose name appears on the card. Monthly reconciliations for all cards issued to the office or department, with the appropriate county official or department head's signature, will be submitted monthly to accounting department.

The Greene County Purchasing Agent shall adopt such rules and regulations as the Purchasing Agent deems necessary to implement this Policy.

Purchasing cards which are used in any manner inconsistent with this Policy are subject to immediate revocation by the Greene County Purchasing Agent.

Greene County Purchasing Card Program Cardholder Agreement

As part of your employment with Greene County, you are being entrusted with a purchasing card to enable you to make purchases on behalf of Greene County. You are authorized to use this card ONLY upon the terms and conditions stated below. Sign this agreement only after reading and agreeing to each of the numbered statements below.

- 1 This card is issued in my name, and I am the only person authorized to use this card. I will not allow anyone else to use the card without written authorization from.
- 2 I understand that I will be making financial commitments on behalf of Greene County and I will strive to obtain the best value for Greene County.
- 3 I have read and will follow the Purchasing Card Policy for Greene County.
- 4 Under no circumstances will I allow this card to be used to make personal purchases, either for myself or others. I understand that personal purchases using this card may be considered misappropriation of Greene County funds. If this card is used to make personal purchases, I agree that I am financially responsible for payment of those charges and any fees related to the collection of those charges.

WHEREAS the expenditure of state highway funds to procure right-of-ways and grading for a 4-lane highway in Greene County but construction of a super- 2-lane highway would not appear to be in the best interests of the citizens of Greene County; and

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of July 2016 the Greene County Commission unanimously approved a resolution requesting the Department of Transportation to revert to the original design of a 4-lane cross section.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Greene County Commission, meeting in regular session on the 18th day of January 2022, a quorum being present and a majority voting in the affirmative, once again requests reconsideration by the Department of Transportation of its decision to build a super 2-lane highway for the three (3) projects referenced above and requests further that the identified projects revert back to their original designs as 4-lane divided highways and be constructed as such.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Court Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Resolution to State Senator Steve Southerland, State Representative David Hawk, and State Representative Jeremy Faison and also to the Commissioner for the Department of Transportation requesting their support to construct 4-lane highways on the aforementioned sections of SR-35 (US 321) as originally designed and contemplated.

This request shall take effect upon passage, the public welfare requiring it.
