

# ABSENTEE AND EARLY VOTING NOTICE

## for the May 3, 2022, State and County Primary Election & the Town of Greeneville City School Board Primary Election

The Greene County Election Commission is hereby publishing notice of the early voting period for the May 3, 2022, State and County Primary and the Town of Greeneville City School Board Primary Elections. Any registered voter who is eligible to vote in the May 3, 2022, Election may vote in person during a period beginning twenty (20) days prior to the election and ending five (5) days before the election (T.C.A. 2-6-102 (a)(1)). This period would run from **Wednesday, April 13, 2022, through Thursday, April 28, 2022.**

### **EARLY VOTING HOURS AND LOCATION:**

To vote in person during early voting, come to the **Election Commission Office located at 311 CCU Blvd, Suite 1, Greeneville, TN 37745.** The hours for early voting are as follows:

- Monday, Wednesday, and Friday- 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- Tuesday and Thursday- 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
- Saturday, April 16, 2022, and April 23, 2022- 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 Noon.

**The Greene County Election Commission Office and early voting will be closed on Friday, April 15, 2022, in observance of Good Friday.**

### **VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:**

The last day to register to vote in person or by postmark for the May 3, 2022, Election is April 4, 2022.

### **PHOTO ID REQUIREMENTS FOR VOTERS:**

If you are voting in person during early voting or on Election Day, a Federal or State of Tennessee Government issued photo ID is required for voting, unless an exception applies. ### **PROCEDURES FOR VOTING ABSENTEE:**

If a voter wishes to vote by mail, you must request a ballot in writing over your signature. The first day to receive a request for the May 3, 2022, County Primary Election was February 2, 2022, and the **last day to receive a request is April 26, 2022.** For more information on absentee by mail eligibility, contact the Greene County Election Commission Office or visit the Tennessee Division of Elections website at [www.GoVoteTN.gov](http://www.GoVoteTN.gov).

**A voter may make the request or submit an application to vote by mail, facsimile transmission, or email with an attached document which includes a scanned signature.**

**The voter's request can serve as the application for ballot if it contains the following information:**

1. The voter's name;
2. The voter's address of residence;
3. The voter's social security number;
4. The voter's date of birth;
5. The address to mail the ballot to;
6. The election in which the voter wishes to participate;
7. The reason the voter is requesting to vote absentee; and
8. The voter's signature.

If the request does not contain all the information listed above, the Election Commission shall send the voter an application for an absentee ballot in order to obtain the needed information.
