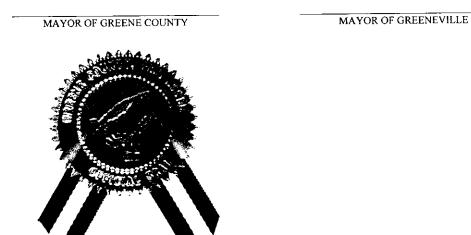

RFP's that were submitted came from Ballad, One Team Health SOPHA and Greene County. Those cost included the Town of Greeneville and Greeneville Light and Power as using the clinic. Erin is also getting price and options on the EMR.

John McInturff suggested that the clinic be added to the self-insured excess fee on liability insurance with \$250,000 SIR. This will not cover the doctor, NP or PA they would add Greene County to their policy. Nurses would be covered. If we added other entities to the clinic then he recommended getting a stand-alone policy.

Motion was made by Danny Lowery and was seconded by Commissioner Peters for Greene County to take over clinic operations effective January 1, 2023, giving Erin Elmore the authorization to hire clinic manager. Ballad will be given a 90-day notice. The decision to add other entities access to utilize the clinic will then come back for the committee to vote on. Motion was then approved with no opposition.

The Board considered a variance request to decrease the front yard setback from fifty (50) feet to twenty (20) feet, for tax parcel 084-G-A-019.00, located adjacent to West Andrew Johnson Highway between Cherokee St. and Pocahontas Street. The property was owned by Jan Crum and Jeremy Crum ETAL/REM, who made the request in order to construct two mini-warehouses on the property. Staff stated that a prefab building was first placed on the 6.4 acre site in 1987, followed by an office building in 1989, two warehouses in 1993, one warehouse in 1995, and five in 2019.

After discussion about the limitations of the property, the potential impact to the surrounding area, and natural buffering on the site, a motion was made by Beth Douthat, seconded by Bill Dabbs, to grant the variance request as it met the three requirements in the *Zoning Resolution* for granting a variance:

- 1. Relief could be granted without substantial detriment to the public good and without substantially impairing the intent and purpose of the zoning resolution.
- 2. The property had exceptional topographical conditions and natural buffering that would result in exceptional practical difficulties to meet the required 50' front yard setback requirement for construction of two mini-warehouses.

3. Mini storage buildings have been an ongoing commercial use on the property for 35 years, without any visible or noticeable impact to the surrounding properties. Building the warehouses within the setback requirements would create undue hardship on the property owner.

The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business, a motion was made by David A. Smith, seconded by Bill Dabbs, to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 a.m.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

Heat Source for the New Building – (Cannon) Says that Adam is going to run enough electric wiring to the building so that if there becomes a need for heat & air later. The use of natural gas for heat in the building was also discussed.

#### Regular Meeting

The Greene County Commission Education Committee met at 3:30 PM at the Greene County Schools Central Office for its regular September meeting.

<u>Committee Members in Attendance</u>: Chairman Bill Dabbs, Lloyd Bowers, and Paul Burkey. Tim White was absent. Director David McLain was present as well.

Others in Attendance: Rick Tipton, Jan Kiker (prospective Committee member)

The Committee reviewed the minutes from 5 July meeting. Mr. Bowers made the motion to accept the minutes. Mr. Burkey seconded. The motion to approve passed unanimously.

Mr. McLain provided TCAP and Value-Added (TVAAS) assessment summaries for the 2021-2022 school year including several superlatives. These include

- 13 perfect TCAP scores from 12 individuals compared to 0 for the previous year
- 64<sup>th</sup> out of 146 school systems in the state for ELA and Math
- 63 of 162 teachers rated at Level 5 (highest level), 25 at Level 4, and 43 at Level 3
- Greene County School System is 1 of 9 systems out of 146 state-wide with Level 5 ratings at all levels (Composite, Literacy, Numeracy, Literacy & Numeracy together, Science, and Social Studies)
- 8 of 15 individual schools rated at Level 5 (Chuckey, Doak, Mosheim, all 4 middle schools and South Greene High School)

Mr. McLain also provided an update on the expansion projects at Chuckey-Doak Middle School (CDMS), West Greene High School and Chuckey-Doak High School. For CDMS, David Myers is the Project Manager and bids for excavation will go out soon. A combination of ESSER and Capital funds is in place to pay for this project. For the two high school CTE expansions, expect bids for overall project management to go out soon. He also reviewed the CTE programming underway at North Greene and South Greene in partnership with Walter State.

The new School Board will have a workshop at West Greene High School at 5:30 PM on Thursday 8 September.
