PROCLAMATION FOR **HUMAN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS MONTH**

WHEREAS, Human trafficking occurs when a person is recruited, harbored, obtained, transported, sold, traded, or exploited through force, fraud, or coercion for the purposes of sexual or labor exploitation, involuntary servitude, debt bondage, or slavery, or when any commercial sex act is committed upon a minor; and

WHEREAS, The malevolent authority of the trafficker facilitates the dehumanization and material commodification of its victims, corrupting the inherent human rights and dignity of each individual; and

WHEREAS, We recognize that human trafficking disproportionately affects those most marginalized in our community, and cultural oppression, including racism and ethnic bias, creates additional risk for exploitation and generates unique challenges for prevention and intervention.

WHEREAS, No community is impervious to the potential for exploitation of its most vulnerable citizens; it is vitally important that all Greene County residents are equipped to recognize and respond to the abhorrent reality of trafficking by disrupting the veil of secrecy that allows it to thrive for the purpose of restoring hope and healing to those affected, assuring victims they have the strength of their community to overcome their victimization experience.

THEREFORE, Aligning with the State of Tennessee and the rest of the nation, Greene County hereby recognizes January as Human Trafficking Awareness Month. During this month, we remember and further our commitment to ending human trafficking in Greene County by:

- promoting awareness through fact-based community education opportunities to unite and equip Greene County to report and respond to this crime;
- fostering and celebrating the new and existing partnerships through fluid dialogue and candid 2. conversation that pave the way for increased collaborative intervention and more robust legislation to end human trafficking and protect survivors;
- furthering an inclusive, community-wide response in which everyone has an important part to play and a moral obligation to work together in collaboration toward ending human trafficking and meeting the needs of those affected;
- creating space to reflect upon and honor the resilience, courage, and perseverance of human trafficking survivors in our community.

The Greene County Legislative Body was in regular session on November 21, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in the Greene County Courthouse.

Mayor Morrison called the meeting to order to transact business that has lawfully come before the Honorable Body. Commissioner Nick Gunter gave the invocation.

Commissioner Bill Dabbs led the Pledge to the Flag.

Mayor Morrison called the meeting to order to transact business that has lawfully come before the Honorable Body. Commissioners Anderson, Arrowood, Bible, Bowers, Burkey, Carpenter, Clemmer, Cobble, Crawford, Dabbs, Gunter, Kiker, Lawing, Murray, Parton, Peters, Quillen, Shelton, Smithson, Waddle, and White were present. There were 21 Commissioners present.

Mayor Morrison announced to the Commissioners that they will have a new updated RollCall system at the December meeting.

Mayor Morrison announced that Troop 92 Boy Scouts were present at the meeting.

Mayor Morrison announced the Proclamation for Adoption Awareness Month.

RECOGNITION FOR CHELSEA HENSLEY WHO REPRESENTED THE CHUCKEY DOAK FFA CHAPTER TO PERFORM IN THE BAND IN INDIANAPOLIS, INDIANA AT THE NATIONAL FFA CONVENTION

Mayor Morrison recognized Chuckey Doak FFA sophomore student, Chelsea Hensley, representing the Chuckey Doak FFA Chapter and Greene County, was selected to perform at the National FFA Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana. Chelsea Hensley was selected as one of the forty-five students across the Nation to perform in the National FFA Courts.

RECOGNITION FOR JOSH DEAN WHO REPRESENTED THE WEST GREENE HIGH FFA CHAPTER TO PERFORM IN THE BAND IN INDIANPOLIS, INDIANA AT THE NATIONAL FFA CONVENTION

Mayor Morrison recognized Josh Dean, a graduate of West Greene High School, representing the West Greene High FFA Chapter and Greene County, was selected as one of the top thirty competitors to perform in the band at the National FFA Convention Indianapolis, Indiana. He graduated from West Greene High School in May 2022.

PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Morrison announced the Judy Sexton was listed on the agenda, although she was unable to attend the November Commission meeting.

Mayor Morrison announced Ada Sloop, Northeast Region Healthy Development Coordinator, spoke in regards of the Healthy Built-Up Grant projects from the \$85,000 grant for public space investments. Mayor Morrison explained the \$85,000 Grant, \$20,000 was used for each walking track at the Ottway, Baileyton, and McDonald Schools. The \$20,000 funds were used at Nolichuckey for playground equipment.

Commissioner Chase Murray called on John Demarko from New Jersery, who spoke in regards to his neighbor building a 10 foot structure which is three feet from the property line.

Commissioner Gary Shelton called on Keith Pruitt who spoke in regards of buying property to build a storage container to live in. He stated that Building and Zoning will not inspect due to the building code regulations.

Commissioner Robin Quillen called on Leanne Spradlin, Wendy Pea with the United Way, Cindy Wilhoit, representative with Drug Recovery Court, and Dr. Robert Locklear with the Greene County Anti-Drug Coalition.

Lee Anne Spradlen spoke to the Commission in regards to the Greene County Anti-Drug Coalition requesting funding from the Opioid Litigation Settlement Funds. Lee Anne Spradlen stated that she was an opioid survivor and overdose survivor. She said," That it is a huge privilege for me to stand up here today and say, that people like me did for my life to save me when I needed it the most. She said the Greene County Anti-Drug Coalition received a \$52,000 Grant from the Tennessee Department of MH and Substance Abuse Services Office of Prevention to support and grow.

This Grant requires up to 75% of the funds to be used for a full-time staff member. At the current level of staffing there are three part-time staff members to support the Coalition, who are Robert Locklear, Lea Anne Spradlen and Cindy Wilhoit.

Wendy Pea, United Way Director also spoke to the Greene County Anti-Drug Coalition to the Commission. The United Way oversees every dollar of disbursement of Greene County Anti-Drug Coalition funds.

Commissioner White asked on how we could help the Greene County Anti-Drug Coalition through the budget process. Commissioner Quillen stated she would present a Resolution to contribute the funds to the Greene County Anti-Drug Coalition.

Commissioners discussed the sale of Delta 8, Delta 9, Delta 10 THC products which are sold at convenient stores.

Commissioner Smithson asked, "Could we do a Resolution to send to the State

Legislators to appeal the sale of the Delta and THC products that are sold to individuals."

County Attorney Roger Woolsey explained to the Commission that if they desired to suspend the rules at the end of this meeting, and vote to send a Resolution to the State Legislators to appeal the sale of Delta and THC products that are sold to individuals at convenient stores, that he would work on the Resolution.

RESOLUTION L: A RESOLUTION TO PURCHASE THE CUTSHALL PROPERTY LOCATED ON THE SNAPPS FERRY ROAD SUBJECT TO AN ACCEPTABLE GEOLOGICAL STUDY

A motion was made by Commissioner Quillen and seconded by Commissioner Kiker to approve a Resolution to purchase the Cutshall property located on the Snapps Ferry Road subject to an acceptable geological study.

Commissioner Carpenter asked Mayor Morrison, "How did the geological study go?" Mayor Morrison said the geological study was very acceptable property. The study was conducted by Tennessee-based company S&ME.

Commissioner Bowers asked if any other sites in the county had been considered for purchase and why the Snapps Ferry property had been the focus for development.

Mayor Morrison responded that the site already having access to water, sewer and gas utilities made the property desirable, along with its closed proximity to a railroad. It was rated as our top property by ECD (Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development) for receiving development grants. The property will be eligible for state economic development grants when it comes in possession of the county. Mayor Morrison said that State grants will be available through the entire development Process. The application for those grants for the next year begins in January.

Mayor Morrison called the Commissioners to vote on their keypads. The following vote was taken: Commissioners Bowers, Burkey, Carpenter, Cobble, Crawford, Dabbs, Gunter, Kiker, Lawing, Murray, Peters, Quillen, Shelton, and Waddle voted yes.

Commissioners Anderson, Bible, Clemmer, Parton, Smithson, and White voted no.

Commissioner Arrowood was absent. The vote was 14 – aye; 6 – nay; and 1 – absent.

The Chairman called the meeting to order and welcomed attendees.

<u>Approval of Minutes</u>. The Chairman asked if members had received the draft minutes of the February 22, 2022 meeting. A motion was made by Bill Dabbs, seconded by Robert Wilhoit, to approve the minutes as written. The motion carried unanimously.

256 Meadowbrook Rd. The Board considered decreasing the front yard setback for 256 Meadowbrook Rd. (tax parcel 088D-D-010.00) from the required 55 feet from the center of the road, to 40 feet from the centerline. Approval of the 15 foot variance would permit the property owner to construct a two-car garage to the left-hand side of an existing carport, matching the setback of the house and car port. Staff stated the front portion of the lot, where the garage would be located was zoned R-1, Low Density Residential District, while the rear portion of the property was zoned A-1, General Agriculture District. The Board was informed that the property was a lot of record, and the house was constructed in 1930, prior to the approval of subdivision regulations for Greene County. Staff stated the location of the septic system on the property limited where an attached garage could be built.
