PROCLAMATION DECLARING APRIL 19, 2023 AS CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS DAY IN GREENE COUNTY, TENNESSEE

WHEREAS: One in every 2,500 pregnancies are diagnosed with a congenital diaphragmatic hernia (CDH); and

WHEREAS: Congenital Diaphragmatic Hernia occurs when a baby's diaphragm fails to fully form; allowing abdominal organs into the chest cavity and preventing lung growth; and

WHEREAS: Since 2000, it is estimated that over 700,000 babies have been born with CDH; however, only 50 percent of those babies survived; and

WHEREAS: CDH is as common as Spina Bifida and Cystic Fibrosis; however, very few people know about it or are aware of it; and

WHEREAS: 1,600 babies are born with CDH every year in the United States each year; and

WHEREAS: There are many people living in Tennessee who have been diagnosed with and have survived their CDH, although many families in Tennessee have endured the horrible pain and grief associated with the loss of loved ones with CDH; and

WHEREAS: CDH International is a charity is a 501(c)III organization that was created to help families affected by CDH; and

WHEREAS: Those with CDH often endure multiple surgeries and possible medical complications beyond their diagnosis that include heart defects, pulmonary complications, gastric and intestinal problems, developmental delays, and may require respiratory and medicinal support for years; and

WHEREAS: Raising awareness of this congenital defect will help bring about acceptance and support for those suffering with it and will help advocate for urgently needed medical research and advances.

THEREFORE, I, Kevin C, Morrison, Mayor of Greene County, do hereby proclaim April 19, 2023 *CONGENITAL DIAPHRAGMATIC HERNIA AWARENESS DAY* and encourage all to join me in this special observance of education and awareness of this too often subdued lifelong medical condition and its impact on our people and our community.

In 2016, there were 143 officers killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, our community is not void of these tragic statistics. We have recorded one Greeneville Police Department and seven Greene County Sheriff's Department officers as having lost their lives in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers are our guardians of safety and peace who play an important role vital to our way of life; and

WHEREAS, it is our responsibility to demonstrate to our law enforcement officers that the citizens of Greene County recognize the difficult career they have chosen; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the value and appreciation of all our law enforcement professionals; now

THEREFORE, I, Kevin C. Morrison, Mayor of Greene County, do hereby proclaim the week of May 15-21, 2023 as NATIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT WEEK in Greene County Tennessee

DISCUSSIONS:

Anthony Shelton, Washington County UT-Extension Agent, spoke on the proposed meat processing facility in Telford. The Appalachian Producers Cooperative is farmer owned and consist of 12 board members who makes decision and they will be rotating. Statistics show that Greene County serves as second largest cattle producing county in the State. Food supply is our main concern. Difference in selling a 5-weight calf at the market verses a finished product. Grant writers are on board and are in the process of receiving them. A lot of interested entities are getting involved. This facility is regional. The location will be near the Jonesborough Flea Market on 11-E, directly across from the Washington County Industrial Park and less than a mile from Grandview Elementary School. The plant will make a generational impact on farmers in the region, as the next generation considers whether to join their family farm or pursue another business. The Appalachian Producers cooperative will be owned by the farmers who use its services. They will have a voice in its use and management. Profits from the facility will be distributed back to members as patronage based on their usage of the facility. Hundreds of farmers will benefit as owner-members of the cooperate. The plan is to eventually make the processing facility a retail market for people to buy locally raised beef, pork, lamb, and goat. Closing date is first of April. Late summer, the facility should be up and running. The more that the Counties are involved, the less worries on how quick is it going to be profitable instead of taking 3 to 4 years to get into the green.

Brian Bartlett, Greene County surveyor, presented a proposal for updated countywide comprehensive land use plan. The main reason is where we want our growth to be, we want to protect our residential, farmlands, manufacturing, and Solar farms. He contacted a consultant out of Ohio, about this and they came back with a proposal and it was presented to planning board and was approved. These folks will come down and have a public meeting and present their plan and take questions. The total cost for all 4 phases is \$100,000. It was suggested that we look at a land use plan for the next 10 to 20 years of growth. The phase process would take roughly a year, consisting of studying current traffic patterns, infrastructures, water system, school systems equipped for growth. For any land use to be projected, the County Commission votes. Mr. Bartlett says this is not clamping down on telling you what you can do or not do with your land. The ideal of this is to give the planning staff and planning commissioner, building inspector and commissioners a guideline deciding what to do with it, if it is not working. Then, it would need to be fixed by areas of zoning and ordinance.

April and May calendars were passed out to Budget committee to see what dates works best for them to

begin budget reviews. Based on when appraisal information coming back, according to Property

Assessor Chuck Jeffers, it may be extended into June.

HR Director Erin Elmore passed out a detail chart that shows the grade and the minimum suggested

increase per every year that the employee has been employed. Guidelines are to have an annual

graduated salary grade target. This is addressing the actual salary study and looking to where the

employees need to be. Employees would only receive it on every fifth year. This would be a motivation

rewarded to people being loyal to Greene County. If we cannot get the Department heads to buy into this,

it will not work. The committee decided that they need to take the numbers and study them. They want to

come up with the best plan.

Sheriff Wesley Holt talked about the 2005 step raise plan. He passed out a sheet taking each employee

based on their years of service to where they need to be on the step raise. This has been proposed in his

budget for the next year.

Commissioner Quillen spoke of a need for new Toughbook computers for EMS. Their current ones are

basically obsolete and are about 6 years old. Quote for 10 tough books is round \$42,500. She will

sponsor a resolution to be looked at in April.

Ms. Crawford made the motion to recommend approval. Ms. Kiker seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

The Chairman called the meeting to order and welcomed attendees. The Chairman asked if members had received the draft minutes of the February 14, 2023 meeting. A motion was made by Gary Rector, seconded by Lyle Parton, to approve the minutes as written. The motion carried unanimously.

Ryan Road rezoning request (Buchner property). The Planning Commission reviewed and considered recommending rezoning of the William and Paula Buchner property, identified as part of tax parcel 005.00-009 located adjacent to Ryan Road, from A-1 General Agriculture District to B-2, General Business District. Approval of the rezoning would permit construction of a clothing store and storage warehousing on the site. Staff stated the proposal involved a mixture of uses, some of which (sale of items made from alpaca wool produced on the property) were permitted in the A-1 district. The storage warehouse and retail uses were required to be in a B-2 zone. Tim Tweed, Building Commissioner, stated that Dollar General stores are permitted in the A-1 zone because they are "general stores" that sell a variety of merchandise to a limited area, whereas the proposal was not for a "general store", as it would sell only a limited type of merchandise. Gwen Lilley stated it would be spot zoning to rezone just this area. Roger Woolsey, Greene County Attorney, explained state law concerning zoning rules and obligations of planning commissions. At Gary Rector's request, Time Tweed listed some of the uses permitted in the B-2 district, such as retail businesses, professional services, commercial printing, wholesale businesses, and alcohol sales. Paula Bucner spoke in favor of the request. A motion was made by Lyle Parton, seconded by Gary Rector, to recommend the rezoning request as the proposed use should not create traffic or a negative impact to the area. A voice vote was conducted, with Lyle Parton, Gary Rector,

Edwin Remine, and Phillip Ottinger voting "yes", and Gwen Lilley and Stevi Misener voting "no". The motion carried, 4-2.

<u>Christopher Bailey Property Section II subdivision</u>. The Planning Commission reviewed and considered granting approval to the Christopher Bailey Property Section II subdivision for one lot totaling 2.00 acres, located adjacent North Massengill Road in the 25th civil district. Staff stated a Certificate of Completion had been signed, all signatures had been obtained, and recommended approval as the plat met all applicable requirements. A motion was made by Gwen Lilley, seconded by Phillip Ottinger, to approve the plat as it met all applicable requirements. The motion carried unanimously.

Fred and Stella Daniels Estate subdivision. The Planning Commission reviewed and considered granting approval to the Fred and Stella Daniels Estate subdivision for three lots totaling 5.56 acres, located adjacent to Lazy Brook Road in the 20th civil district. Staff recommending granting approval subject to the addition of signatures as the plat met all other applicable requirements. A motion was made by Gwen Lilley, seconded by Lyle Parton, to approve the plat subject to the addition of signatures as it met all other applicable requirements. The motion carried unanimously.

Noel Bowser, Timothy Bowser, and Renee Kuehl subdivision. The Planning Commission reviewed and considered granting approval to the Noel Bowser, Timothy Bowser, and Renee Kuehl subdivision for one lot totaling 0.755 acres, located adjacent to West Pines Road in the 17th civil district. Staff stated the Certificate of Completion had been signed and recommended approval subject to the addition of signatures as the plat met all other applicable requirements. A motion was made by Lyle Parton, seconded by Gary Rector, to approve the plat subject to the addition of signatures, as the plat met all other applicable requirements. The motion carried unanimously.

Land Swap Plat for Darryl Schultz etux and Mike Davis etux subdivision (Replat of Lot 6 & 8 – Quincy Easterly Farm). The Planning Commission reviewed and considered granting approval to the Land Swap Plat for Darryl Schultz etux and Mike Davis etux (Replat of Lot 6 & 8 – Quincy Easterly Farm) subdivision for three lots totaling 2.731 acres, located adjacent to Easterly Drive in the 9th civil district. Staff stated that 0.156 acres would be taken from Lot 8R and added to Lot 6R, and 0.120 acres would be taken from Lot 6R and added to Lot 6A. Each of the three lots would meet the minimum requirements for lot size and frontage. Staff recommending granting approval subject to the addition of signatures as the plat met all other applicable requirements. A motion was made by Gwen Lilley, seconded by Phillip Ottinger, to approve the plat subject to the addition of the signature as the plat met all other applicable requirements. The motion carried unanimously.

Ricky Ball and Vina Ball subdivision. The Planning Commission reviewed and considered granting approval to the Ricky Ball and Vina Ball subdivision for three lots totaling 8.294 acres, located adjacent to Bewley's Chapel Road in the 4th civil district. Staff stated that all signatures except for that of the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC), had been obtained, and recommending granting approval subject to the addition of a signature for TDEC as the plat met all other applicable requirements. A motion was made by Lyle Parton, seconded by Gary Rector, to approve the plat subject to the addition of the signature, as the plat met all other applicable requirements. The motion carried unanimously.

Replat of Willow Springs subdivision concept plan. The Planning Commission reviewed and considered granting approval to a concept plan for the Replat of Willow Springs subdivision, Lots 72R, 73R, and 88R, for three lots totaling 1.9 acres, located adjacent to Choctaw Drive in the 14th civil district. While approval of Lots 72R and 88R was straightforward, Lot 73R had a confusing history. The original Lot 73, which met lot size requirements when approved in 1970, contained 0.32 acres. In 2017 Lot 73R was created by adding 0.57 acres from property adjoining the rear of the lot (total size 0.89 acres). The deed for the new lot did not reflect that Lot 73R included additional land, which was discovered recently when the property was to be sold. The new plat being discussed by the Planning Commission proposed that Lot 73R, now Lot 73R-1, be reduced to its original size of 0.32 acres. Roger Woolsey stated that once a legal nonconforming lot was brought into compliance with County regulations, as occurred in 2017, the lot could not revert to its nonconforming status. As Article 601.3 of the Greene County Zoning Resolution required a minimum 0.5 acre lot size, and the proposal was for a 0.32 acre lot, the plat could not be approved. A motion was made by Gwen Lilley, seconded by Phillip Ottinger, to deny approval to the plat as it would create a lot in violation of Article 601.3 of the Greene County Zoning Resolution. The motion carried unanimously.

<u>Administrative minor subdivisions</u>. The Planning Commission was informed the following subdivisions had been approved since the last meeting.

- Cooter 4.19 acre property subdivision for one lot totaling 4.19 acres, located adjacent to Old Stage Road in the 15th civil district.
- Gene and Florence Waddell subdivision for two lots totaling 7.04 acres, located adjacent to Horse Creek Park Road in the 1st civil district.
- Replat of lots 2 and 3, former Brooks Farm subdivision, plat cabinet K, slide 981, located adjacent to Sunnyside Road in the 24th civil district.
- Tom and Tim Leonard subdivision for one lot totaling 4.00 acres, located adjacent to Buckingham Road in the 24th civil district.

A motion was made by Phillip Ottinger, seconded by Lyle Parton, to accept the list. The motion carried unanimously.

Monthly activity report for Building/Zoning/Planning Office. Tim Tweed discussed the monthly department activity report. A motion was made by Gary Rector, seconded by Lyle Parton, to accept the report. The motion carried unanimously.

Other Business.

Right-of-way dedication. Roger Woolsey stated he had talked with Kevin Swatsell, other county attorneys, and the County Technical Advisory Service (CTAS) about the change in state law concerning the dedication of right-of-way without compensation when a property is subdivided. His understanding of the situation was that dedication could be required if there were justifiable reasons for doing so, such as needing to be able to improve existing roads that were inadequate for safe two-way traffic, a lack of adequate ROW that would result in difficulty providing utility service, or similar issues. Mr. Woolsey stated that preparing a blanket policy would likely lead to a court challenge, and suggested that staff work on a policy that would provide criteria for when dedication would be required, and consider each plat on a case by case basis.

No action was taken.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Edwin Remine, seconded by Lyle Parton, to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 2:27 p.m.

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR PROCEEDS RECEIVED FROM THE SALE OF CATTLE

WHEREAS, Greene County Animal Control Department received a complaint on August 8, 2022 from a resident property owner concerning her neighbor's cattle running at large damaging her property and imposing a significant risk to citizens traveling on roads in her community; and

WHEREAS, Animal Control investigated and contacted the owner of the cattle who advised that he had been attempting to corral the cattle but had been unable to do so thus far; and

WHEREAS, Animal Control received additional complaints from other neighbors about the cattle running at large and again contacted the owner of the cattle who advised that he had successfully caught several head of cattle, had then hired different individuals to attempt to corral the remaining cattle running at large using horses, four wheelers, and other methods to catch the remaining at large cattle but had no further success and was out of options; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the cattle executed a release surrendering the remaining cattle running at large to Animal Control allowing Greene County Animal Control to use its best efforts to catch the cattle; and

WHEREAS, Animal Control with the assistance of other individuals using necessary equipment and supplies located and captured the cattle which were then sold at the Volunteer Livestock Market; and

WHEREAS the funds of six thousand, eight hundred thirty-one dollars and eighty-seven cents (\$6,831.87) derived from the sale of these cows were deposited with Greene County Government; and

WHEREAS, Animal Control has expended many hours and utilized its resources in taking care of this issue for the citizens of that community and it appears that those funds above



specified should be allocated to the Animal Control Department to pay for expenses related to capturing those wild cattle, to pay partial restitution to certain property owners who suffered damages from these cattle running at large for an extended period of time, with the remainder of the proceeds utilized to partially reimburse Animal Control for their time and expense in capturing these cattle.
